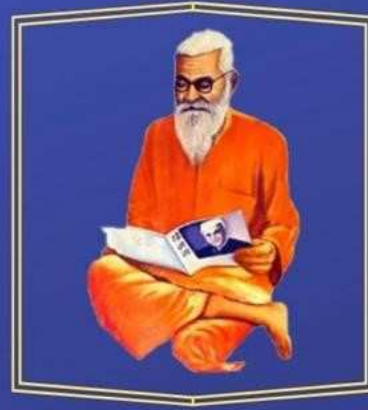

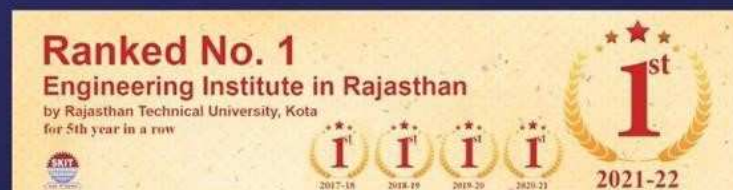

INTRODUCTION:

Day-4:

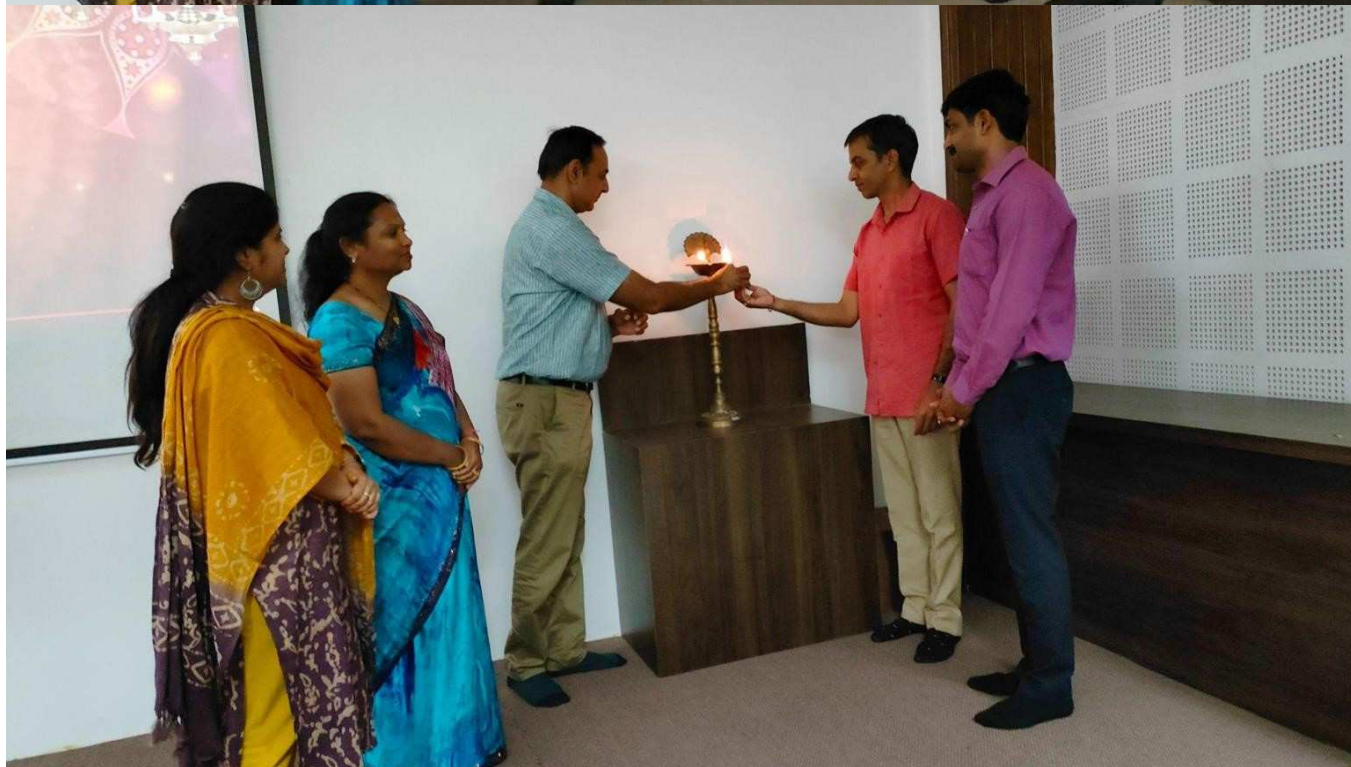
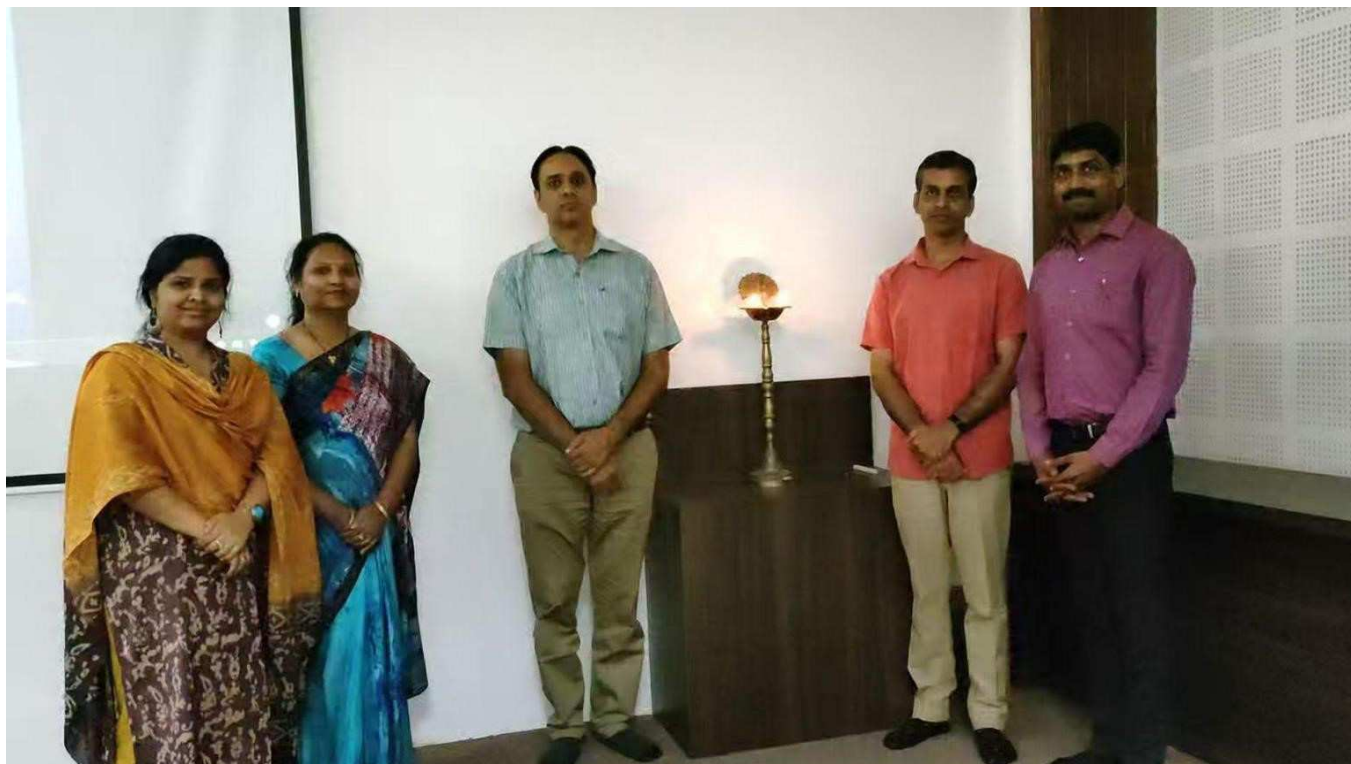
