Technical report

Day 1, 4th Dec 2023; Topic: Understanding Intellectual Property & Prior Art Search

One-week MDP was inaugurated at MSME, DFO, Jaipur on 4th December 2023. The MDP was organized by MSME, DFO, Jaipur. The coordinator of the event was Mrs. Anila Choraria, Assistant Director. She welcomed all the dignitaries and participants of the event and spoke about the objectives and the need for the event. The Chief Guest of the event was Sh. Gaurav Joshi, Joint Director, MSME DFO, Jaipur. He spoke about IP creations and their rights, encouraging participants to focus on the commercialization of the product and take trademarks. Commercialization is the process of bringing a product or service to market and maximizing its potential for profitability. In this journey, trademarks play a pivotal role as powerful assets in establishing brand identity, ensuring consumer trust, and differentiating products or services from competitors. He urged participants to make the most out of the event. The Special Guest of the inaugural ceremony was Smt. Malvika Bagaria, Director, Faculty of Management Studies, VGU. She explained that a trademark is a distinctive sign, symbol, or logo that represents the source of goods or services. It serves as a visual emblem of a brand's reputation, quality, and values. As a critical component of intellectual property, trademarks are invaluable in the commercialization process. She emphasized the importance of creating a brand, stating that a trademark is one of the essential aspects. She also focused on IP creation, highlighting its role as a catalyst for progress, offering a framework that balances the interests of creators, innovators, and society at large. As we navigate an ever-evolving landscape of ideas and technologies, fostering a culture that values and protects intellectual property remains integral to sustaining innovation and driving positive change.

Then, Dr. Mayank Baranwal started Day 1, Session II with his lecture. He covered the Introduction to IP, focusing on IP and legislations governing intellectual property law in India. He discussed various aspects of IP law, providing an in-depth exploration of the patenting process, including application filing, examination, and granting. Case studies were presented on successful and unsuccessful patent creation. The day progressed with sessions III and IV delivered by Dr. Bharti Jain, Founder of SwaSh Legal Consultants, New Delhi. She enlightened the participants on prior art search on patents. We conducted hands-on practice sessions on prior

art, learning how to search and compare different patents on various sites before filing. Dr. Jain provided insights into various platforms for patent searches, such as Google Patent Search, WIPO, PQAI AI-enabled patent search, Patent Scope, etc. The session then covered patents, trademarks, design, and copyright.

Day 2, 5th Dec 2023; Topic: IP Protection and Registration

The day commenced with a lecture by Dr. Bharti Jain, who conducted all four sessions. She delved into the role of intellectual property (IP) in academia, emphasizing the identification of IP potential in research and IP generation from academic research. Dr. Jain discussed various case studies focused on IP creation in educational institutions, highlighting that the role of intellectual property in academia extends beyond protecting ideas; it serves as a catalyst for innovation, collaboration, and societal progress. Identifying and harnessing the IP potential within academic research not only advances the frontiers of knowledge but also ensures that the benefits of this knowledge reach the broader world. It is a dynamic interplay between discovery, protection, and application that drives positive change and propels societies towards a more innovative and sustainable future. The day progressed with a focus on patent drafting, specifically claims writing. Dr. Bharti taught us how to draft a patent and write claims, emphasizing the crucial role of claim writing in the patent drafting process. She provided insights into key points for drafting a claim. The session also included a practical exercise on the identification and safeguarding of intellectual property.

Day 3, 6th Dec 2023; Topic: Licensing and Regulatory Aspects in Patents

The day commenced with a session on compliance and regulatory aspects led by Dr. Bharti Jain. She provided insights into the legal framework, emphasizing timely filing and renewals, and comprehensive compliance involved in conducting due diligence. This process aims to identify and mitigate potential legal risks associated with intellectual property (IP), safeguarding against infringement claims or challenges. Beyond legal requirements, IP compliance includes ethical considerations, such as respecting the rights of other innovators and fostering fair competition, thereby cultivating a culture of integrity within the intellectual property landscape.

The subsequent session focused on licensing IP to external parties. Dr. Jain emphasized that this is a powerful strategy for monetizing innovations and expanding their reach. Considerations such as uniqueness, market demand, and potential value of each intellectual property were discussed. Following lunch, the session covered contractual agreements like Non-Disclosure Agreements (NDAs) and licensing agreements. Dr. Jain highlighted the importance of NDAs, emphasizing their role as legal instruments that protect sensitive information shared between parties. These agreements establish a confidential relationship, outlining the terms under which information can be disclosed and how it should be handled. Meticulously crafting NDAs and Licensing Agreements allows parties to establish clear expectations, protect their intellectual assets, and build successful, legally sound collaborations. The last session of the day focused on IP ownership in funding and collaborative research. Dr. Jain discussed how to open a startup and register on the Government portal under the Startup India initiative. She shared information about various schemes and funding agencies, providing guidance on the application process.

Day 4, 7th Dec 2023; Topic: Technology-Transfer-IP Commercialization

The day commenced with an enthusiastic session on researchers bridging the gap between academia and industry, led by Sh. Rajneesh Kumar, Head of Technology Transfer Officer (Institute Wide) at BITS, Pilani. He discussed the 'death valley' between industry and academia and how funding and resources attempt to bridge this gap. The 'valley of death' concept was explored in terms of maximizing performance, efficiency, and reliability. Additionally, Mr. Kumar addressed gaps in manufacturing innovation, highlighted where innovations and products stand on Technology Readiness Level (TRL) levels, and introduced the new technology business lifecycle and industry demands. The second session focused on IP commercialization and considerations during research. Mr. Rajneesh Kumar emphasized that by integrating these considerations into the research and commercialization process, researchers can optimize the potential impact of their work, facilitating successful transitions from laboratory discoveries to real-world applications.

After lunch, the third session covered sources of funding for IP filing, validation, development, and commercialization, led by Dr. Bharti Jain. The final session of the day focused on schemes

and programs of STPI for startups, innovations, and institutes, delivered by Shri Raj Kumar Verma, Additional Director & Officer in Charge (OIC) at STPI.

Day 5, 8th Dec 2023; Topic: Funding for innovation and IP commercialization

The concluding day of the MDP commenced with a session on the schemes of the Office of DC-MSME, with a specific focus on Intellectual Property Rights (IPR) and incubation. The following session, led by Shri. Aditya Sharma, Assistant Development Engineer (BD) at NRDC, delved into the role of NRDC in IP, innovation, and technology transfer-commercialization. Mr. Sharma highlighted the vital role of the National Research Development Corporation (NRDC), established in 1953 under the Department of Scientific and Industrial Research (DSIR), in promoting, developing, and commercializing technologies and innovations from various research institutions. NRDC acts as a crucial bridge between research and industry, facilitating economic development through technology transfer and commercialization.

After lunch, Sh. Sai Krishna, Scientist In-charge at CSIR-CEERI, Jaipur, discussed the role of CSIR-CEERI in technology transfer-commercialization in IP. He emphasized CEERI's pivotal role in technology transfer, research, innovations, IP creation, and collaboration with institutes and industries. The day concluded with a valedictory session featuring Sh. V. K. Sharma, Director MSME, Jaipur, as the guest. He emphasized the importance of innovation reaching commercialization, urging innovators to collaborate and focus on selling their products. The journey from IP creation to commercialization, he noted, is a dynamic and iterative process requiring foresight, adaptability, and collaboration.

The vote of thanks was given by Mrs. Anila Choraria, who expressed gratitude to all guests and participants for making the event a success. Certificates were distributed to the participants. The MDP proved to be a valuable learning experience, emphasizing the dynamic partnership between Intellectual Property (IP) and commercialization. IP, encompassing patents, trademarks, copyrights, and trade secrets, forms the foundation for protecting groundbreaking ideas and inventions, ensuring a fair and competitive marketplace.
