- IV. Many alumni believe that their prestigious college must align its syllabus to current industry needs and technology. Emphasis should be made upon creating startups incubator and intensive research labs. In adopting the New, the existing value system of our college should not be compensated at any cost.
- V. More alumni interactions should be organized to apprise the current students about the latest trends in the industry.
- VI. Building an environment to encourage students for startups, educating them on how to build startup, how to raise funding, How to manage startup, How to implement ideas.
- VII. The alumni appreciate the placement structure of the CS, IT and EC branches but the placement opportunities for the core branches may be increased.
- VIII. More efforts are needed for soft skills and industry preparedness. More mock tests and mock interviews for non CS students should be organized.
