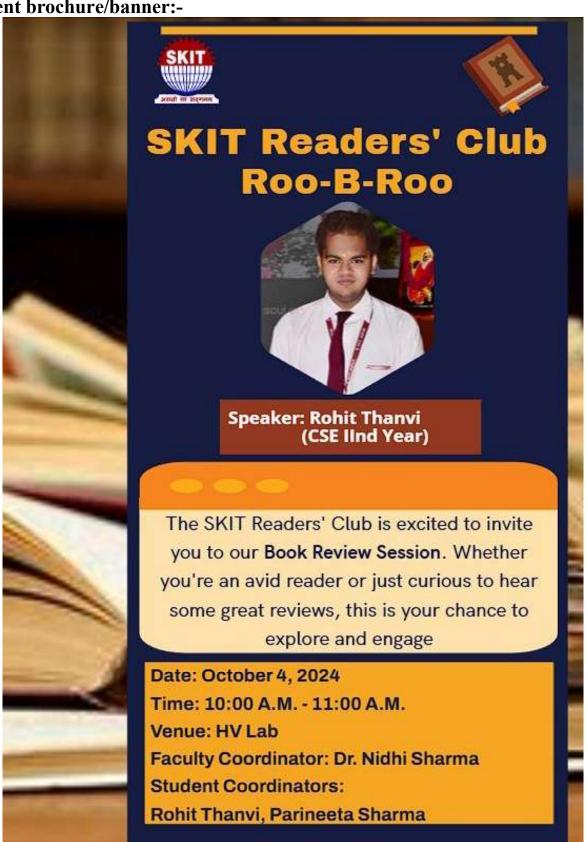


## Man's Search for Meaning

# 1. Event Gist: Book Review on *Man's Search for Meaning* by Viktor Frankl

#### 1.1. Overview of the Session:

On 4th October 2024, the Reader's Club of SKIT held an hour-long session in the HV Lab of the Civil Block. The event featured a presentation by Rohit Thanvi, who explored Viktor Frankl's seminal work *Man's Search for Meaning*. The session was designed to introduce students to the core themes of the book, namely finding meaning and purpose in life's challenges, and to foster critical discussions on how these ideas can be applied in the students' academic and personal lives.

#### 1.2. Purpose of the Session:

#### The session aimed to:

- Offer a comprehensive review of Viktor Frankl's philosophy of logotherapy.
- Engage students in a deeper reflection on the human capacity for resilience.
- Inspire students to think critically about their own search for meaning and purpose.
- Enrich the participants' vocabulary and intellectual framework through discussion of a profound literary work.

#### 1.3. Presentation Structure:

# Rohit Thanvi's presentation was structured into three primary segments:

## Introduction to Viktor Frankl and Logotherapy:

Rohit began with an introduction to Viktor Frankl's background as a Holocaust survivor and a psychiatrist, setting the context for the ideas discussed in the book. The concept of *logotherapy*, which centres on finding meaning in life, was introduced as the philosophical and psychological framework that underpins Frankl's narrative.

#### • Summary of Man's Search for Meaning:

The core of the presentation focused on the book's two parts: Frankl's harrowing experiences in Nazi concentration camps and the development of logotherapy. Rohit highlighted the way Frankl's personal suffering led him to conclude that life's meaning can be found in any situation, even the most brutal. Specific examples from Frankl's life were used to illustrate the power of the human spirit to transcend suffering.

#### • Key Themes and Takeaways for Students:

In this segment, Rohit connected the book's themes to the students' own lives. He discussed how the concept of "meaning"

could help students navigate academic pressures, personal challenges, and future uncertainties. By focusing on the *will to meaning*—a central idea in logotherapy—students were encouraged to find purpose in their studies and personal endeavours.

#### 1.4. Engaging Activities:

#### Interactive Discussion:

Rohit invited the audience to share their thoughts on the role of meaning in overcoming hardship. Several students participated in an open discussion, offering insights into how they could apply Frankl's philosophy to their own lives.

#### 1.5. Audience Engagement and Feedback:

The audience consisted of both students and faculty members who were highly engaged throughout the session. The interactive format, combined with the philosophical depth of the topic, sparked meaningful conversations. Several participants expressed that the session had provided them with a new perspective on handling challenges, not only in their academic journey but also in their personal lives.

#### 2. Reflections and Takeaways

The session underscored the relevance of Viktor Frankl's work in modern academic and personal contexts. Students left the session with a clearer understanding of the importance of having a sense of purpose and the mental resilience needed to overcome life's adversities. Furthermore, the event succeeded in broadening participants' intellectual horizons, as they engaged with complex

philosophical concepts in a practical, student-centred manner.

#### 3. Conclusion

In conclusion, the Reader's Club session on 4th October 2024 was a resounding success, effectively combining literary analysis with personal development. Rohit Thanvi's exploration of Viktor Frankl's *Man's Search for Meaning* offered attendees both intellectual stimulation and practical insights. The discussion of logotherapy, resilience, and the search for meaning will undoubtedly have a lasting impact on the participants, encouraging them to seek out meaning in their everyday lives and future endeavours.

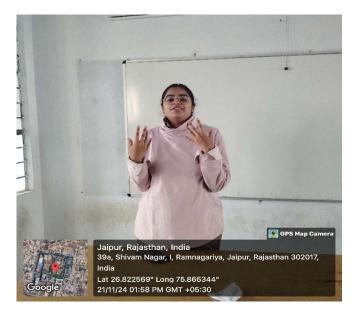

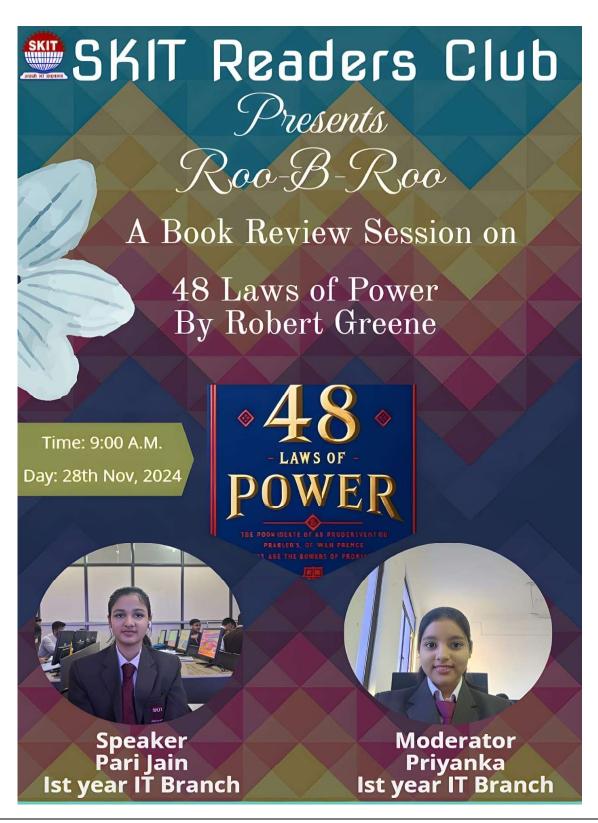
