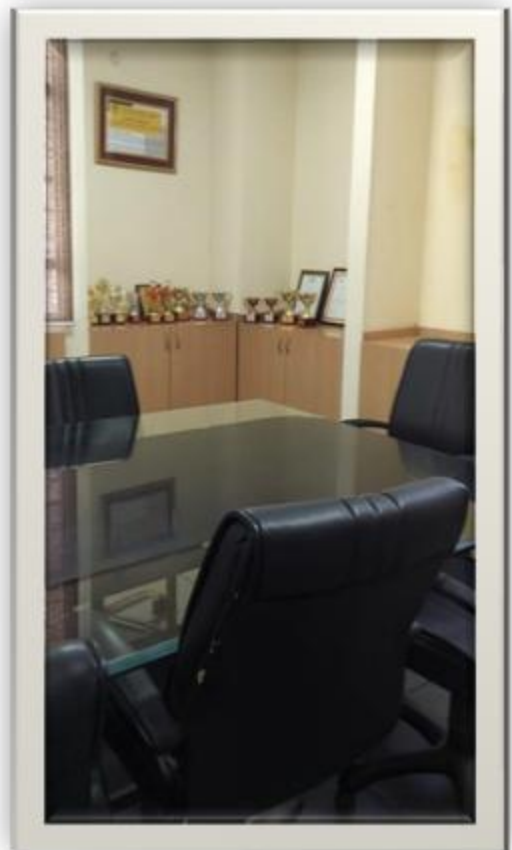
As this is pandemic time and students are not coming regularly to the institute, it was decided to run possible activities via inline mode only.

The event concluded with a vote of thanks and question answer and feedback session.

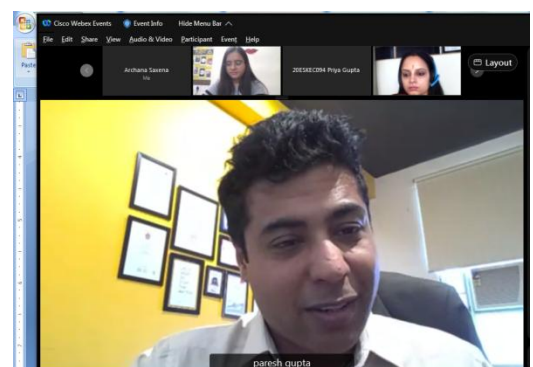
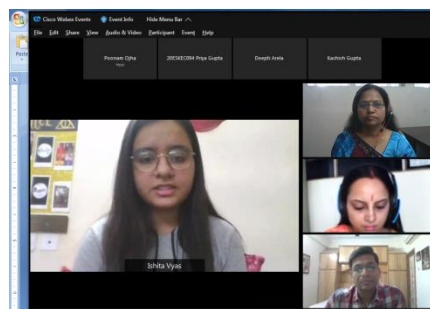
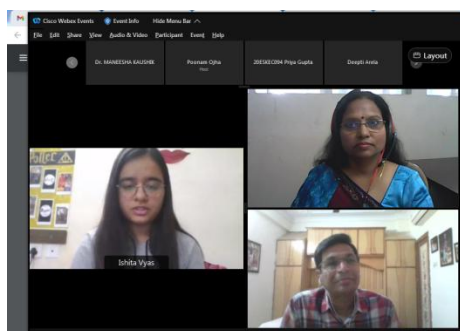
