Mr. Tushar Thanvi and Mr. Sudhanshu Sawnani also shared their experiences about working with the E-cell and motivated the team for their future.






#### Day3, round 3-Start-up Riot


Round 3 was a surprise round. The qualified participants were given a day to think for their own start-up idea and prepare a presentation of 12-15 slides. The finalists, with

There is no single measure of success, and certainly no single answer for how to be



commenced with highly motivational and inspirational session by the key note speaker\


