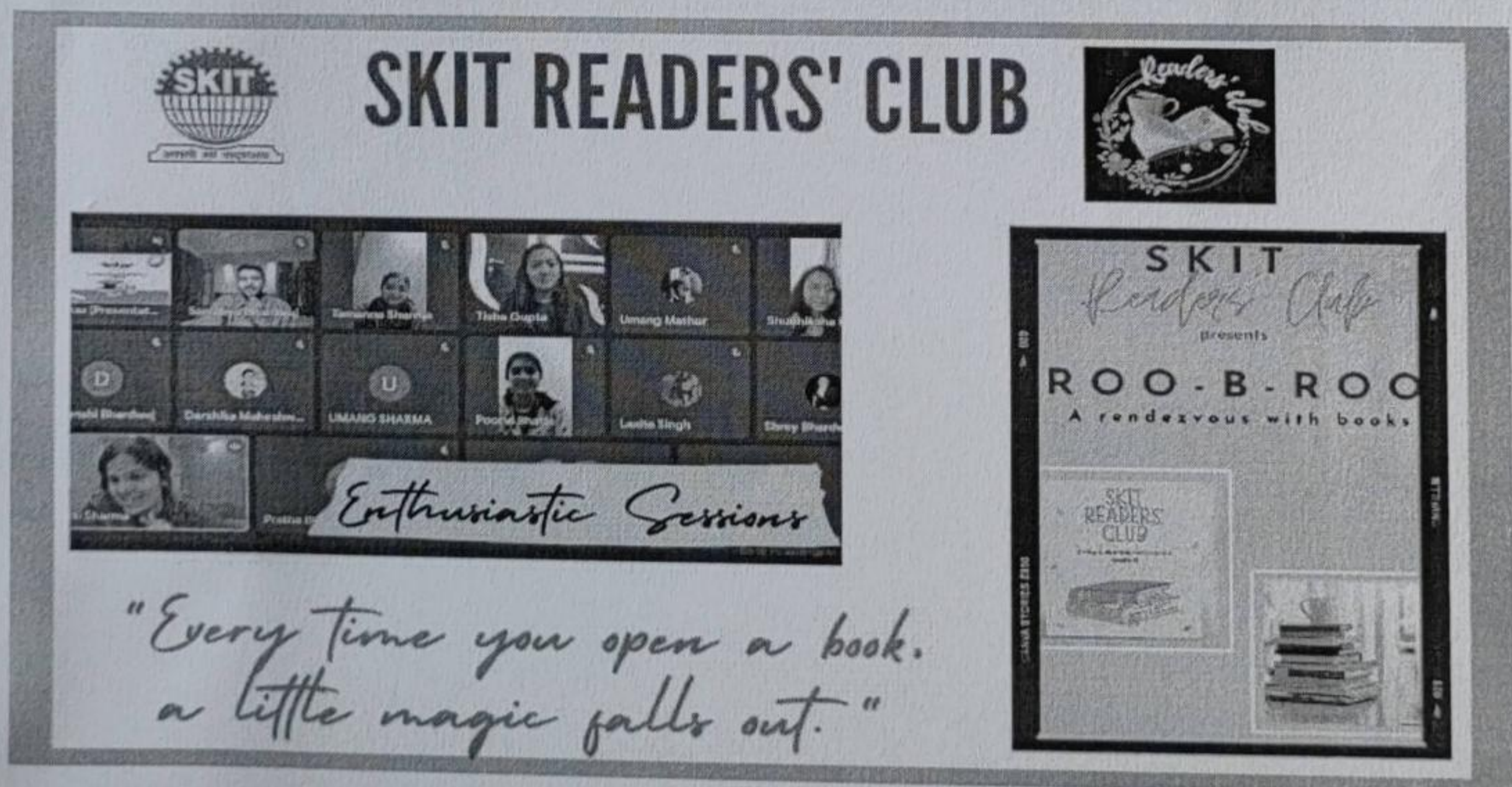

4. An activity "ROO--B—ROO' A Rendezvous with Books" a discussion on book "ALL THE BRIGHT PLACES" by JENNIFER NIVEN was conducted on 31 October 2021.
5. Roobroo Talk Show was conducted on 5 March, 2022 with Umang as the speaker and Shubhiksha as the moderator.

ABOUT THE CLUB: Skit Reader's Club is a platform which provides people with an opportunity to feature themselves as a speaker on the novels of their own interest, to promote reading on a greater level and make books interesting to talk about.

OBJECTIVES:

Book clubs promote a love of literature in a positive, nurturing environment. The purpose of any club is to bring a community together to learn about and discuss something that matters to them, and a book club is no different.

OUTCOMES:

- **Broaden and deepen their vocabulary bank.** Students are usually introduced to “new” or unfamiliar words in each book that they read. Teachers can pre-teach words before they read. Students can identify and write the meaning of new words during tasks related to book clubs. Students may benefit from learning the synonyms and antonyms of the new word. Students may also benefit from attaching a picture to the new word. The new words can be added to a “dictionary” for them to use as reference later. Student discussions related to the “new” word(s) can increase the clarity of the meaning and retention of the word meaning.
- **Improve comprehension of written words.** It is important to note that “a word may produce all degrees of erroneous meaning for a given context, from a slight inadequacy to an extreme perversion” (Thorndike, 1917). Every student will gain different information or insight from a book, as every student has a different environmental background. Some students will need to learn the meaning of words before reading to be able to comprehend the words within the book, others will not need this information to digest the words. Group discussions about the meaning of a passage or book usually increases comprehension.
- **Develop better writing skills.** Students can learn and practice how to formulate written responses to questions related to the passage or book. Students can journal their thoughts or a summary related to the reading.
- **Improve oral verbiage skills.** Students can learn the correct pronunciation of words. Students may learn how to have a “healthy”, but respectful discussion about the book. Students can learn how to formulate questions to ask during collaborative work. Students can also learn how to digest others’ opinions or facts into new questions.
- **Development or improvement of research skills.** Students may develop research skills through activities related to book clubs. Students may learn where to find information related to the book, like where to find words meanings or what are windmills. Students can formulate questions related to the book and then interview another person who is knowledgeable about the subject matter.

HOW THE CLUB WORKS: Every week a moderator is selected which gets to interact with the speaker who will speak on the favourite book of his or her.

Moderator and the audience ask various questions about the book to the speaker in order to know the book better.

One of the main objectives of this club is to connect Readers on a social level to share their ideas and experiences while reading.

The Talk Show for students was held on 27<sup>th</sup> November 2021 at 5:00PM on GOOGLE MEET, by the SKIT READERS' CLUB.

The Book that was being discussed- THE ALCHEMIST BY PAULO COELHO



The event started with the brief introduction of the club and the participants from the anchor of the event. Then the mic was handed over to the moderator (Tamanna ) and the speaker(Sanidhya ) and the discussion about the book was held. Several questions were asked by the moderator and the audience to the speaker in order to know more about the book.

The plot begins when an Andalusian shepherd boy named Santiago consults a Gypsy fortune-teller about the meaning of a recurring dream. The woman interprets it as a prophecy, telling the boy that he will discover a treasure at the Egyptian pyramids. After Santiago sets out, he meets an old king Melchizedek, or the king of Salem, who tells him to sell his sheep so as to travel to Egypt and accomplish his 'Personal Legend'. Early on his arrival in Africa, a man who claims to be able to take Santiago to the pyramids instead robs him of the money he had made from his flock. Santiago then has to work for a crystal merchant so to earn enough to get to the pyramids. Along the way, the boy meets an Englishman who has come in search of an alchemist and continues his travels with his new companion. When they reach an oasis, Santiago meets and falls in love with an Arabian girl named Fatima, to whom he proposes marriage. She promises to marry him only after he completes his journey. Frustrated at first, he later learns that true love will not stop nor must one sacrifice one's destiny to it, since to do so robs it of truth. The boy then encounters a wise alchemist, who teaches him to realize his true self. Together, they risk a journey through the territory of warring tribes, where Santiago is forced to demonstrate his oneness with "the soul of the world" by turning himself into a dust storm before he is allowed to proceed. When he begins digging within sight of the pyramids, he is robbed yet again, but accidentally learns from the leader of the thieves that the treasure he sought was all along in the ruined church where he had his original dream.

The event started with the brief introduction of the club and the participants from the anchor of the event. Then the mic was handed over to the moderator (Darshika Maheshwari) and the speaker (Aayushman Mishra) and the discussion about the book was held. Several questions were asked by the moderator and the audience to the speaker in order to know more about the book.

The plot revolves around Lenin the man who would come to be known as Lenin was born Vladimir Ilyich Ulyanov on April 22, 1870, in the Russian city of Simbirsk, which lay on the great River Volga. Like many revolutionaries, Lenin was born into relative prosperity: his father, Ilya Nikolayevich Ulyanov, was a university-educated civil servant, working as a government inspector of schools in the service of the Tsar, while his mother Maria was the daughter of a wealthy German doctor. The fourth of nine children, seven of whom survived childhood, Lenin enjoyed a comfortable, if hardly opulent, childhood as his father rose higher in government service, eventually receiving the title of "State Councillor," which gave him the right to be addressed as "Your Excellency." His sons, especially Lenin and his older brother Alexander, were expected to follow this career path when they completed their education.



Thereafter, as his family came under surveillance by the Tsar's secret police and began to move around frequently, he devoted himself to discovering all he could about his executed brother's political convictions. He enrolled as a student at the university at Kazan, a large city upriver from Simbirsk, but he quickly became involved in subversive activity, and was expelled in December 1887 for taking part in student protests.

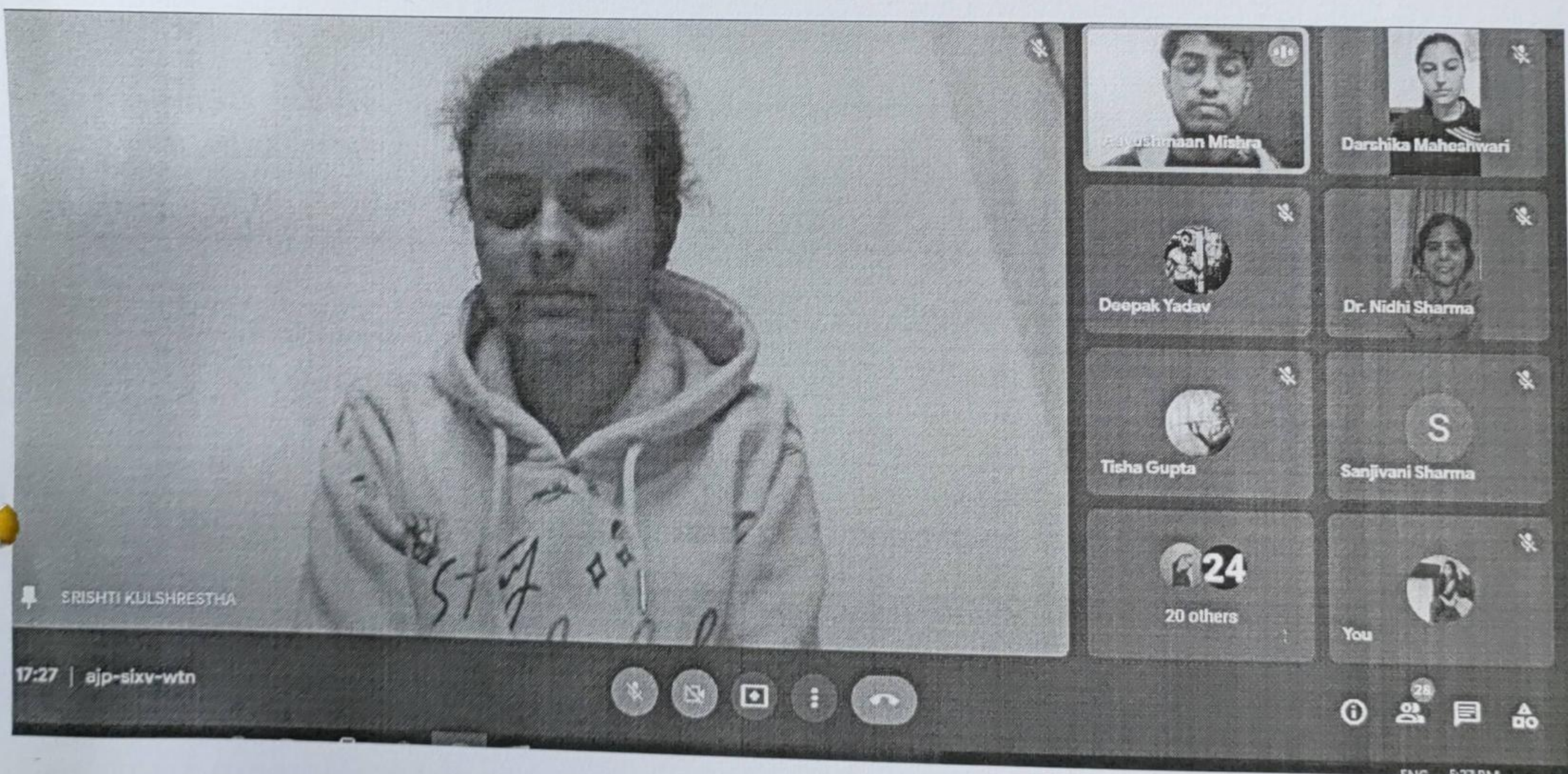

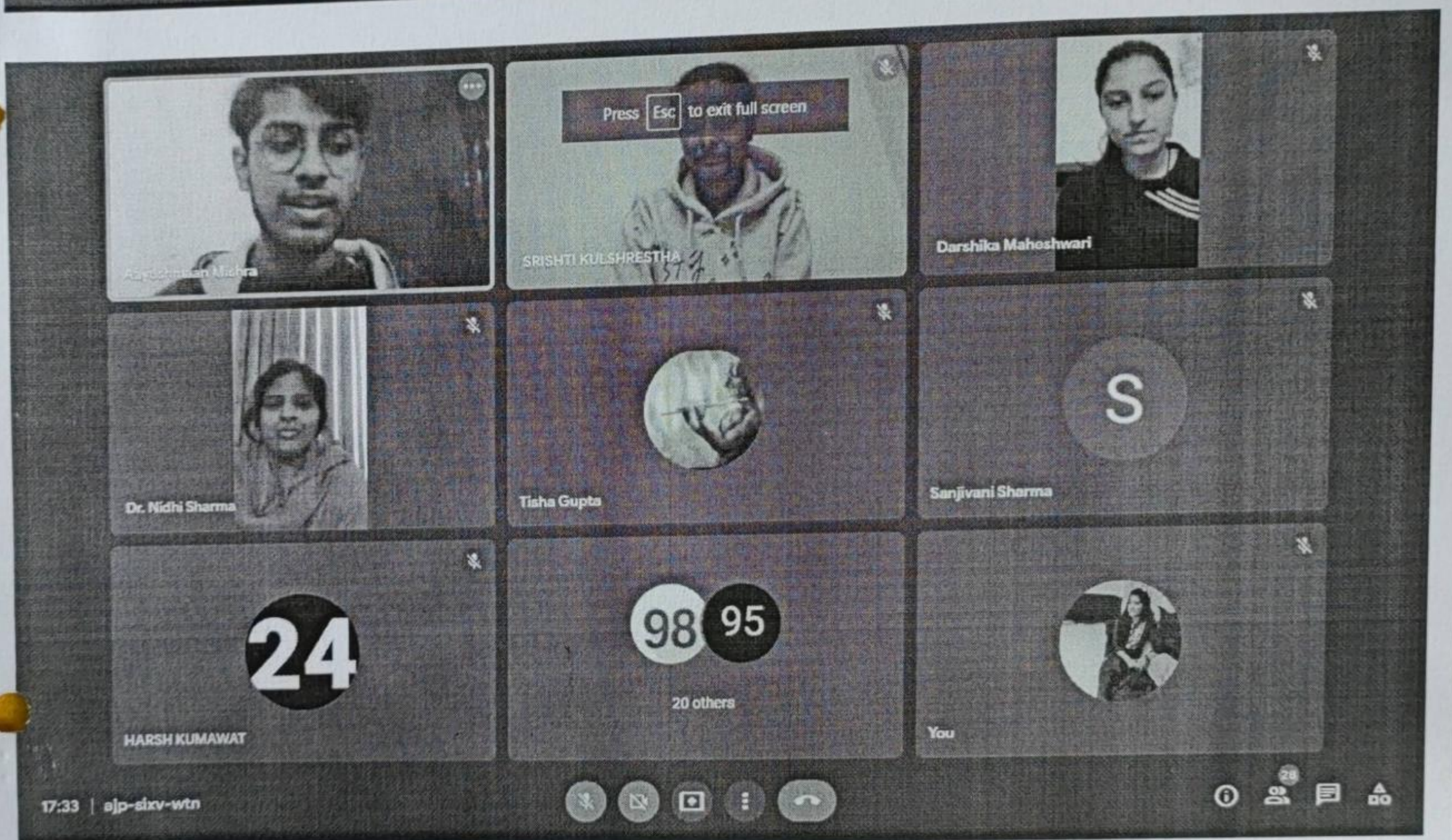
