**Introduction:** 

#### What is LSRW?

L-S-R-W is a set of four capabilities that allow an individual to comprehend and produce language for proper and effective interpersonal communication. These skills are **Listening**, **Speaking**, **Reading**, **and Writing**. In the context of language acquisition, the four skills are most often acquired in the order of listening first, then speaking, then possibly reading and writing. Hence, these abilities are frequently called LSRW way of Learning.

## Why LSRW is necessary for students?

In present scenario of market placement patterns, effective communication offers an edge to outshine and showcase one's skills more effectively. Currently, students who are very good in technicalskills are lagging in communication. When it comes to 21st-century skills, most organizations today are looking for employees who can handle challenges, navigate conflicts and communicate with impact. Communication is one of the most sought-after skills in the modern workplace. So, it makes sense to invest time and effort for building these four skills. Whether one is a fresh graduate looking for first job or a seasoned professional who wants to switch careers, LSRW abilities are the four pillars of effective communication that will help in facilitating quick growth in all areas of life.

This workshop aims to provide assistance for the students to acquire the four skills of Language learning to become industry ready.

#### AIMS AND OBJECTIVES OF THE WORKSHOP

#### Aims: -

#### To enable the learner -

- a) to communicate effectively and appropriately in real-life situations.
- b) to develop and integrate the use of the four language skills i.e. Reading, Listening, Speaking, Writing.
- c) to encourage students to think on their own and form their ideas using their experience, knowledge and imagination than being text or teacher dependent.

Students participating in thisworkshop will develop their skills in reading, writing and speaking English in an intensive study situation.

# **Objectives: -**

#### Listening

## By the end of the course, students should be able to:

- 1. identify and apply the purpose of listening (e.g. for pleasure, general interest, specific information etc.)
- 2. listen to a talk and understand the topic and main points and interpret messages conveyed in person or by telephone;
- 3. listen for information required for a specific purpose (e.g. radio broadcast, commentaries, airport and railway station announcements);
- 4. understand and respond appropriately to instruction, advice, request and warning.

#### **Speaking**

### By the end of the Course, Students should be able to:

- 1. adopt different strategies to convey ideas effectively according to purpose, topic and audience (including the polite expressions);
- 2. narrate events and incidents, real or imaginary in a logical sequence;
- 3. present oral reports or summaries, make announcements, clearly and confidently;
- 4. take active part in discussions;

#### Reading

By the end of the workshop, students should be able to:

- 1. adopt different strategies for reading different types of text, both literary and non-literary.
- 2. identify the main points of a text;
- 3. anticipate and predict what will come next in the text;
- 4. consult a dictionary/ thesaurus to obtain information on the meaning and use of synonyms/ antonyms;
- 5. analyse, interpret, infer and evaluate the ideas in the textby relating them to other material on the same theme

### Writing

#### By the end of the course, students should be able to:

- 1. plan, organise and present ideas coherently by introducing, developing and concluding atopic;
- 2. write a clear description (e.g., of a place, a person, an object or a system);
- 3. write a clear account of events (e.g., process, a narrative, a trend or a cause-effect relationship);
- 4. present an argument or persuasion supporting it with appropriate examples;
- 5. summarise or make notes from a given text; and

- **Day 1**: It began with a session on 'Listening Skills'. Dr Anupriyadiscussed about the significance of effective listening, types of listeners, and barriers to listening. Towards the end of the session, the participants were apprised of various effective listening techniques and the benefits of effective listening.
- **Day 2**: The second day kickstarted with a session on "Speaking Skills" by Dr Anupriya Singh. Some of the major problems like Why are most people afraid of public speaking? What bad habits prevent us from being heard? What steps can we take to become better public speakers were effectively dealt with. The students were also shown videos related to it.
- **Day 3**: The third session dealt with 'Reading Skills'. The participants were taught about the importance of reading. Prof. Krishna played several videos showing how reading can make one a better speaker and writer. The students were also made aware of the different reading strategies and their appropriateness in different situations such as reading for pleasure, newspaper reading, reading for exams etc.
- **Day 4**: It began with a session on 'Writing Skills'. Prof Krishna told the students that good writing skill is not an inborn talent rather it has to be learnt. She highlighted the role of creative and analytical thinking in developing good writing. The differences between good and bad writing were shown to the students with the help of some videos.
- **Day 5**: On the last day of the workshop, the students were made to listen to the story, "The Last Leaf", on which they were asked several questions related to the four skills. The participants answered with full zeal and gave positive feedback about the workshop.


