

Day - 1, 4th Aug 2020, Tuesday

Session – 1: Inauguration

The Inauguration began with remembering mother Saraswati Goddess with shlokas and prayers to bless us all with knowledge and wisdom so that the entire world be in pease, prosperity and harmony.

Address by Prof. S.L. Surana, Director Academics, SKIT, Jaipur

Atmanirbhare Bharat: Encouraging Enterprise in Rural Communities and Remote Regions India is currently passing through a very difficult phase. Even before COVID19 the Indian economy was already in poor health. The GDP growth sliped to mere 4.6 % in February 2020. On top of this COVID19 which has not only caused a big health crisis but damaged the economy further. The initial lockdown in the country forced all big and small industries to close down resulting in massive unemployment in the country. Millions of workers left their places of works in the cities and moved to their native villages. After three lockdowns the Government of India declared partial unlockdown to revive economy. But the economy of the country in several sectors hit the subzero territory. In some of the sectors GDP growth went as low as-9.5%. Along side COVID19 which is spreading in the country at an alarming rate our neighbour China is bent upon creating problem along the line of actual control at the Galwan Valley and in Arunachal. Our Government has taken appropriate action to combat both these problems, that is COVID 19 and that created by China at the LAC. The Government has realized that making India self reliant is most important and we should stop depending upon the imported products. Make in India will only make our country Atmanirbhar. In fact Mahatma Gandhi long back in 1947 said that if we want to wipe the tears from the eyes of every poor person in the country we must make our villages self reliant where 70% of country's population live. In the current situation of COVID19 the schemes announced by the Govt. of India for MSMEs and for corporates like reduction in corporate tax to revive Indian economy may not work well because very little efforts have been put to revive demand. People do not have spare money to buy goods and unless and until demand is generated production cannot sustain. The two sectors in which currently there is demand are agriculture sector and pharmaceutical sector. In order to make villages self reliant agriculture sector must be given top priority. Entrepreneurs must be encouraged to start agro based industries in villages. Farmers must be educated about new techniques of farming including proper use of organic fertilizers, proper, irrigation techniques to reduce water consumption and at the same time gives higher yield. Every year large amount of farm produce gets spoiled as there are no proper cold storage systems available to nearby villages. The entrepreneurs who construct solar power operated cold storage systems may be given subsidy and for relief in taxes. Also entrepreneurs must be encouraged to open food processing units and food packaging units. This will not only save millions of tons of farm produce from getting spoiled but will generate additional income due to enhanced value of their produce. Animal husbandry is another area in which villagers can be trained to produce quality milk and milk products. Focus on agriculture sector can generate huge employment opportunities in villages which will prevent migration of population from villages to cities. Further several problems of cities like housing, water supply, transport, waste management, sanitation, pollution and several other problems will automatically get solved partially. Due to COVID19 the slogan of Globalization has failed completely. We have realized the risks of

Due to COVID19 the slogan of Globalization has failed completely. We have realized the risks of over dependence on supply chains from one nation. During the last few years our trade with China increased many fold, our imports from China currently is several times more than what we export. Baring a few specialized electronic items and some pharmacy products, the most of the items which we import from China can be easily designed and manufactured in India, Our entrepreneurs can easily produce them with domestic technology. The ministry of commerce and industry has identified 371 items in 20 different sectors for increasing import duties. Our entrepreneurs must seize this golden opportunity and gear up to produce these 371 items particularly in rural areas. This path will not only help the country to recover its economy but will improve livelihood conditions of rural population in an equitable and sustainable manner and also partially solve urban problems.

Address by Prof. R.A. Gupta, VC, RTU Kota Chief Guest

Prof. R A Gupta VC, RTU Kota graced the occasion as Chief Guest. He emphasized upon the need to strengthen the rural enterprising to make India Atamnirbhar. He said that technical institutions are doing very good in most of the fields nearly 60-70%, what we can to add in it, is to bring technology to every people which can bring a positive change in their livelihood.

Applied part of knowledge is very important and this should be given much emphasis. He also threw light on the various entrepreneurial possibilities of rural areas.

Entrepreneurship is one of the most effective and efficient solutions to the unemployment issues at hand as well as ensuring the deployment of our vast pool of human resources.

He congratulated the organizers for selecting such a relevant subject of FDP. He also stated that Entrepreneurship cells of the institutes must be strengthened.

He said that in the present scenario of KOVID and order challenges "Aatmnirbharta" is necessary. He told that we should work together to meet these challenges. Entrepreneurship in Rural and remote areas will bring happiness all over and will make a equitable society.
