MUTUAL NON-DISCLOSURE AND CONFIDENTIALITY AGREEMENT

This is an agreement ("Agreement" hereafter) between:

For the purposes of this Agreement, the party that discloses Confidential Information to the other party shall be referred to as the "Disclosing Party", and the party that receives such Confidential Information from the other party shall be referred to as the "Recipient".

The Recipient may be given access to the Disclosing Party's Confidential Information or to create new Confidential Information for the Disclosing Party.

In view of the above, the parties agree as follows:

1. Confidential Information

"Confidential Information" includes any information:

- the Recipient creates or produces while performing its obligations under this Agreement,

 obtained said information and the right to its disclosure.
- is developed independently by Recipient without use of or reference to the Disclosing Party's information.

2. Restrictions on Use

- (a) The Recipient will not disclose any Confidential Information to third parties for any purpose without the prior written consent of the Disclosing Party. 
