About the Seminar

Corporate Social Responsibility means that a company takes steps to ensure there are positive social and environmental effects associated with the way the business operates. Businesses that engage in active CSR efforts take stock of the way they operate in the world to incorporate addressing cultural and social issues, with the aim of benefiting both in the process. Not only can CSR models increase business and revenue, they promote change and progress throughout the world, which often involves helping people with few or no resources. Businesses that ignore corporate social responsibility run a risk to their bottom line and their brand. Having a bad reputation socially and environmentally can create serious negative effects on the overall profitability and success of a company, as nowadays consumers want to spend their money on products and services that they believe in, and engage with companies that follow ethical practices that meet their own beliefs.

Once revenues flow in, they are expected to put a percentage of their net profits into areas that directly impact national development goals. This investment must necessarily have a catalytic role for it to generate genuine and perceptible impact on the ground. Collaborative effort through strategic partnerships is a powerful way to succeed. On the basis of this, the corporate must formulate a comprehensive CSR Policy that should suitably inform the design, development, implementation, monitoring, evaluation and reporting of responsive projects and programmes.

With this reasoning in mind, the Indian Parliament enacted the Companies Act 2013 that replaced the Companies Act 1956. Section 135 of the new Act makes setting up of a CSR process, governance structure and allocation of a CSR budget mandatory for a stipulated category of profit making companies. This is a historic development, and India becomes the first country in the world to make CSR mandatory with such high order of transparency and accountability. An alert CSR Committee of the Board of every such Company must closely monitor the CSR Policy and its implementation to ensure that all projects and programmes are actually delivered in an effective manner. The new legislation is very innovative, making substantive provisions that will also help monitor and report all activities undertaken. It is imperative for corporate managements at all levels in India to understand the scope, objective and concept of CSR to

leverage its potential for creating a positive impact in the society. This impact must be visible and rupee measurable. In this way, the company can also build its brand image.
