Dr. Maneesha Kaushik, Convenor, National Seminar, in her initial remarks said that, the knowledge for foreign trade policies is extremely crucial for the budding managers as well as for the development of our nation.

Shri. C.K. Mishra, JT. DGFT from Directorate General of Foreign Trade in his address talked about the three crucial parts which encompasses Foreign Trade-

### Part I

- Six Step Export Procedure
  - 1. Product and Buyer-Seller Decision.
  - 2. Background check and Understand Export/Import Database.
  - 3. Find HS(Harmonised System) Code Administered by WCO.
  - 4. Find your Item type (Free, Restricted, State Trading Enterprises STEs, Prohibited Items).
  - 5. Analyse Export-Import data (<a href="http://commerce.nic.in/eidb/Default.asp">http://commerce.nic.in/eidb/Default.asp</a>).
  - 6. Find Buyer(Website, Distributers, Dealers, Exhibition, Advertising and marketing, Surfing)

### Part II

 Major agencies involved in exports -DGFT, RCMC,Banks, BRC, ECGC,EIA, EXIM Banks.

### Part III

- DGFT's Support Mechanism Involves a Handbook of procedures, Simplification& Merger of Reward Schemes (MEIS & SEIS), Incentives for SEZs and Duty credit scrips.
- Foreign trade policy 2015-20 (Boost to Make in India), Reduced Export Obligation (EO) under EPCG Scheme, paperless trade in 24\*7 environment, online inter-ministerial consultations, digitisation and e-governance

He also addressed about the importance of analyzing Export-Import Data and mentioned various sites for the same- icegate.gov.in, indiantradeportal.in etc.He also discussed about the role of Central Board of Excise and Customs (CBEC) as a part of Department of Revenue under the Ministry of Finance, Government of India. He participants were also made aware regarding Export Promotion Councils (presently 14 export promotion councils under Ministry of Commerce). These Councils operate as non-profit organizations and perform both advisory and executive functions. They also issue RCMC(Registration cum Membership Certificate)

After that Shri Satish Raina, I/C EDI addressed on forthcoming E-Governance initiates like online issuance of Export Obligation Discharge Certificate (EODC), Message exchange with Ministry of Corporate Affairs for CIN ,DIN and CBDT for PAN. He talked about various methods of payments, consignments, letter of credit etc. He further shared about B/L – Bill of Lading Issued by Carrier Company, Airway Bill, ECGC(Export Credit Guarantee Corporation of India Ltd.), EIAs (Export Inspection Agencies) and EXIM Bank.

Shri Bhupinder Singh from Federation of Indian Export Organization addressed about their assistance being provided to Indian Entrepreneurs and motivated the participants to think on the lines of becoming an exporter and help improve Indian exports too. He also discussed about BRC (Bank Realization Certificate) and DGFT's incentives, import duty exemptions and other financial assistance to the exporters.

Towards the end of the National Seminar Dr. Ona Ladiwal, Associate Professor, DMS, thanked all the dignities for effective participation in the National Seminar and making it a great success.
