NATIONAL CONFERENCE BY CIVIL ENGINEERING DEPARTMENT ON “DEVELOPMENT OF SMART CITIES FOR A BETTER WORLD” – NCDSC-2017

The Department of Civil Engineering in collaboration with The Institution of Engineers (India) organized a national conference on “Development of Smart Cities for A Better World” on 18 and 19 August 2017.

The conference witnessed intellectual deliberations in plenary sessions and research paper presentations at parallel sessions. The inaugural ceremony was held on 18th August in Gyan Mandir auditorium. NEXT LEVEL MANAGERS (LEARNING SERIES) SESSION WITH MS. ANAMIKA SAINI

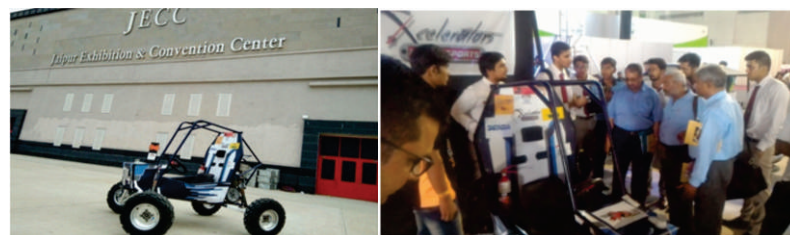

SURVEY CAMP ORGANIZED BY CIVIL ENGINEERING DEPARTMENT

A survey camp was conducted for B. Tech 3rd year (V-semester) Batch 2015-19 students from 4/10/2017 to 14/10/2017 at Chandwaji near Jaipur-Delhi (NH-8) highway in which the participating students practically performed a triangulation survey of the area near Sevad Mata Temple.

Initially, they carried a reconnaissance survey of the area to be surveyed. Then stations were erected at different locations in the village. A total of seven stations were selected, four of which are located at hills near the village. Savad Mata's temple also was used as a triangular station. The inter-visibility of all the stations was checked and a baseline was drawn in front of the temple. The students worked with theodolites observing horizontal and vertical angles and calculating distances with the help of the trigonometrical formulae. At the center point for measurement of horizontal and vertical angles the Total Station was used. A leveling



exercise was done with the help of an auto-level instrument. At the end, the students were able to draw a triangulation map and also calculate elevation of all triangular stations. Apart from the technical exercise, the students learnt team work and management skills as they were divided into 7 different groups with each group having a group leader and a person in charge of instruments. The remaining members of the groups were responsible for other activities. This camp was managed by Er. Manmohan Sharma and Er. Ankur Mishra.
