## **Report of Staff Development Program**

(27th September, 4th October & 11th October, 2017)

#### I. Introduction

A three-day Staff Development Program was scheduled on three Wednesdays, beginning 27.09.2017. The program was planned for laboratory & workshop staff (laboratory assistants, technicians, technical assistants & foremen). Also laboratory incharges were invited to attend the program. The main purpose of the program was to bring together all laboratory and workshop staff so that they are able to see their importance in the functioning of the departments and the institute as well as teaching-learning processes.

Although various departments / sections have been running staff development and training - retraining programs for their own staff, this was the first attempt to have a common program for staff from all the departments.

It is heartening that all the departments cooperated whole heartedly and sent almost all the staff from their departments to attend the program. A few faculty members were also sent.

List of staff and faculty members who attended the program with their attendance is given in Appendix I.

#### II. Target Group

As stated above, target group was all laboratory & workshop staff. Though this group is homogeneous functionally because it is having similar roles and responsibilities; it is not homogeneous in their language and communication skills. Due to this, in program delivery this aspect was considered an important factor and taken into consideration during presentations and discussions. Another non-homogeneity is the position of participants in SKIT; there was mix of senior and junior staff and also their years of service in the institute. They also felt that such programs be organized for them on a regular basis. Also a need for skill development in computer usage was felt by some participants. Departments may plan such programs for their technicians or / and all technicians who may be interested in specific skill development.

Another need expressed was providing short training to those staff who get involved during admissions so that uniform and correct information is conveyed to parents and guardians who visit the Institute during admission time. Some of the technicians felt that they remain with parents and guardians for a fairly long period, and they are asked questions of all types. A training program can be arranged in the beginning of admission session for this purpose. Also if a list of usual questions asked by parents and guardians is prepared and their answers written down and given to those involved with the admission process, it would be a good training investment.
