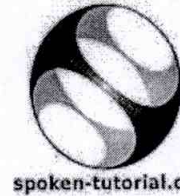



9. Spoken tutorial, IIT Bombay will provide a Relationship Manager to SKIT Jaipur as a single point of contact for all support and service.


Content Rights:
