Report

Five day online Faculty Development Program (FDP) on "Intellectual property Rights in Management, Innovations & Academics" was by Department of Management Studies, SKIT on January 18-22, 2021.

Intellectual Property Rights (IPR) is the rights given to persons over the creations of their minds. They usually give the creator an exclusive right over the use of his/her creation for a certain period of time. The rights of authors of literary and artistic works (such as books and other writings, musical compositions, paintings, sculpture, computer programs and films) are protected by copyright, for a minimum period of 50 years after the death of the author. Industrial property can usefully be divided into two main areas: One area can be characterized as the protection of distinctive signs, in particular trademarks (which distinguish the goods or services of one undertaking from those of other undertakings) and geographical indications (which identify a good as originating in a place where a given characteristic of the good is essentially attributable to its geographical origin). The protection of such distinctive signs aims to stimulate and ensure fair competition and to protect consumers, by enabling them to make informed choices between various goods and services. The protection may last indefinitely, provided the sign in question continues to be distinctive. Other types of industrial property are protected primarily to stimulate innovation, design and the creation of technology. In this category falls all the inventions (protected by patents), industrial designs and trade secrets. A functioning intellectual property regime should also facilitate the transfer of technology in the form of foreign direct investment, joint ventures and licensing. The protection is usually given for a finite term (typically 20 years in the case of patents). The FDP is well structured and covers various aspects on Intellectual Property Rights (IPRs) that are concerned with the protection of tangible and intangible property.

IPR protection plays a key role in gaining modest advantage in terms of technological gains for achieving higher economic growth in a market driven economy. The main aim of FDP is to impart greater awareness about the issue of IPRs, which gained a special importance for all the domains of socio-economic development.

Objectives of the FDP:

The main objective of the FDP was to create awareness among participants about the basics of Intellectual Property Rights (IPR) especially patents and to guide the inventors in respect of patenting their innovation. Following the important points:

- To describe about origin and evolution of IPR
- To make participants aware about various components of IPR
- To learn the process of applying for IPR in India.
- To awareness about National IPR Policy
- To discuss about Issues in India's IPR Regime

Day: 1

The FDP was started with a welcome memo by Dr. Savita Choudhary, Organizing Secretary –of the event. In the first session Dr. Pooja Thalreja discussed about the Concept & Relevance of IPR. She marked various cases of copyrights and patents to present the importance of IPR. The session helped the participants to think beyond the curriculum introducing inter disciplinary thinking and briefed about design thinking. She fostered innovative minds among participants Day: 2

In the second session CA Veer Jain explained the various types of IPR and its Components. He discussed about the Copyrights, Patents and Trademark of various companies to present practical view in it. He also enlightened the participants on the financial benefits of IPR. He explained about the trademark and copyright laws. He discussed why the copyrights and trademarks play a major role in patenting and its necessity.

Day: 3

The third session Dr. Pooja Thalreja explains the process of applying for IPR like Copyright, Patents and Trademark in India. She highlighted various cases related to registration of IPR and its benefits. She created awareness about intellectual property rights (IPR) specially the patents.

She provided necessary guidance and training about various procedures of patent search and application filing.

Day: 4 &5

The fourth session was taken by Dr. Swati Jain her topic was National Policy of IPR. She demonstrated about drafting of a complete specification report and defending a patent through the examination procedure at the Patent Office. And the last session was taken by CA Veer Jain who discussed about many issues of Indian Regime of IPR. These sessions were followed by question-answer session, discussion and view points of the participants and speakers. The FDP concluded with Valedictory session wherein the certificates were distributed to all the participants. E- Mementos were also given to the experts. 
