### **Report of the FDP**

Five days Faculty Development Programme on the topic "Personal Effectiveness" was organized by Department of Management Studies, SKIT from 5<sup>th</sup> October, 2020 to 9<sup>th</sup> October, 2020 through virtual platform (Google Meet).

On day the FDP was started with a welcome note by Dr. Atul Gupta, Coordinator-FDP. He welcomed all the delegates and participants in this FDP and also briefed about the theme and objectives of the FDP. Followed to this Prof. (Dr.) S.L. Surana, Director (Academics), SKIT, in his address discussed the various issues on FDP theme. He gave his best wishes to the participants and explain the importance of the personal effectiveness for the teachers. Mr. Jaipal Meel, Director, SKIT discussed the concept of Self-confidence, Self-motivation and Value system. He also emphasized on the self assessment for teachers.

The first session of the FDP was on "Defining Personal Effectiveness". Prof. Amber Srivastava, HOD Mathematics Department SKIT was the expert of the session. Mr. Srivastava explained the personal effectiveness in a new way to participants. He also focused on importance of self esteem and role of discipline in life.

The second session was on Assertive Communication. Prof. Anil Choudhary, HOD IT Department, SKIT was the session expert. He discussed examples of various cases that how people achieved success through discipline in their life and at workplace. Further he explained that assertive communication involves clear, honest statements about your beliefs, needs, and emotions. When we communicate assertively, we share our opinions without judging others for theirs.

On day two the third session was on Persuasive Communication by Prof. Nirija Saraswat, Professor English department, MNIT, Jaipur. Firstly, she advised the participants to have right responses at the right time i.e. adaptability to situations, secondly, she narrated a story depicting how an persuasive communication or a challenge can be plant to grow in life.

The Fourth session was on Speaking to Win by Prof. Anil Mehta, HOD Business Administration Department, Manipal University. Prof, Mehta explained that The ability to speak with confidence and deliver winning presentations can accelerate our career, earn people's great respect, and enable you to achieve your greatest-even most impossible-seeming goals and it is very important for a teacher so that he can excel the career of their students. His words were indeed inspirational. Further he explained that teacher should be confident, positive, and relaxed in front of any students; grab attention from the start; use body language, props, and vocal techniques to keep students engaged; transition smoothly from one point to the next; use humor, stories, quotes, and questions skillfully.

On day III the fifth session was conducted on the topic Time Management. Prof. Mukesh Jain, Associate Professor, Department of Business Administration, University of Rajasthan was the session expert. Prof. Jain explained that Good time management enables an individual to complete more in a shorter period of time, lowers stress, and leads to career success. Further he urged that with effective time management skills, teachers can increase their productivity and provide a better education for their students.

The sixth session was on Readiness to Change. Dr. Savita Choudhary, Associate Professor, Department of Management Studies, SKIT was the session expert. She explained that the teachers who have the readiness to change will be able to inspire the students to prepare for a changing world and hard competitions. In other words, the teachers' readiness to change will affect the performance.

On day IV the seventh session of FDP was conducted on the topic Nurturing Creativity. Dr. Ona Ladiwal, Associate Professor, Department of Management Studies, SKIT was the session expert. She explained that journey into the realm of creativity, where children and teachers try new ideas and grow into creative, critical thinkers who are free to make mistakes and encouraged to learn from them. Further is pointed that It's not imperative that every person be "creative," but life in the 21s century increasingly requires us to exercise more creativity, teachers and students alike.

Without this skill, teachers risk losing jobs to AI, and students risk falling short on their true potential.

Eighth session was on Perception Management by Prof. Vikas Shrotriya, Associate Dean, Vivakanda University, Jaipur. He explained the importance of Perception Management for teachers. Further he focused on Well-managed classrooms which characterized as safe environments where learning occurs freely. Worldwide teachers are faced with the task of continuously facilitating and implementing educational reform that has been designed without their participation.

On day fifth the IX session was on Writing to Win by Prof. Prof. Anil Choudhary. He said that classroom is, if anything, a dynamic place. With so much going on at any given time, how can teachers be sure that what they're doing is making positive impact on students' learning? High quality teaching is now widely acknowledged to be the most important school-level factor influencing student achievement. This in turn has focused attention on the importance of teacher education, from initial training and induction for beginning teachers, to on-going professional development to help update teachers' knowledge, deepen their understanding and advance their skills as expert practitioners.

The FDP was concluded with Valedictory session wherein the certificates were distributed to all the participants. Mementos were also given to the Key note Speakers of the FDP. Prof. Ramesh Kumar Pacher, Principal, SKIT proposed a vote of thanks to all delegates, Organizing and Technical Committees for smooth conduct and huge success of FDP. The FDP was well designed and implemented by the Coordinator Dr. Atul Gupta, Associate Professor-DMS. The FDP has attained its objectives and was a great success.

- Managing yourself is about controlling events, setting priorities, utilizing time effectively, changing habits, continuous improvement
- Time management essentials include not creating impossible situations, defining priorities, avoiding distractions, floundering and stress
- Track your progress
- Limit you scope (Don't do everybody's job-let them do their job)
- In a professional setting one need to be persuasive in their communication style and passionate in their behavioral approach.


