

### Preamble

The first record of the voluntary blood donation initiative in India is noted in 1942, at the time of World War II and the first blood bank was established in Kolkata, West Bengal. The blood bank was set up at that time to fulfill the blood needs of those injured in the battle field. Government employees and industrial houses volunteered to donate blood for this humanitarian cause. Once the war ended, the enthusiasm waned and blood bank collections were largely from professional or the paid blood donors. A decade passed by till Mrs. Leela Moolgaokar initiated voluntary blood donation drive in Bombay (now Mumbai) from 1954 onwards. She was inspired by the blood need of her injured son. In 1971, Prof. J.G. Jolly the founder President of the Indian Society of Blood Transfusion and Immunohaematology took the movement to further heights and the Society under his stewardship declared **October 1 as National Voluntary Blood Donation** Day which was later accepted by the government too. Since then many blood donor organizations came up in different regions of the country in support of the noble cause of voluntary blood donation. The National Blood Policy (2002) and an Action Plan for Blood Safety (2003) were adopted by the Government of India. The NBTC (National Blood Transfusion Council) was entrusted with planning a national campaign.

There are four main blood types: A, B, AB and O. In 1901, Karl Landsteiner, an Austrian physician, discovers the first three human blood groups. On his birthday **June 14th ''World Blood Donors Day'' is celebrated.** 

SKIT has always been engaged in the activities of human concern and societal & environmental development. We have been organizing Blood donation camps since long time.

17th Annual Mega Voluntary Blood Donation Camp was organized on 1st October 2018 (National Blood Donation Day) by SKIT Red Cross Club & NSS Club.

This session (2018-2019) we organized two camps. Over whelming response of blood donors was amazing. Our sincere efforts have witnessed a progressive increase in voluntary blood donation every year. The concern for blood donor safety was also taken care of. The current scenario is definitely hopeful. Seasonal variations also account for fluctuations in blood collections.

Thus in conclusion it can be stated with confidence that our Blood donation programme is successfully gaining strength.





## Blood Facts

### **Blood: Life-maintaining fluid**

- Blood is the life-maintaining fluid that circulates through the body's heart, arteries, veins and capillaries.
- Blood carries to the body nourishment, electrolytes, hormones, vitamins, antibodies, heat, and oxygen.
- Blood carries away from the body waste matter and carbon dioxide.
- Blood fights against infection and helps heal wounds, keeping you healthy.
- Blood makes up about 7% of your body's weight.
- A newborn baby has about one cup of blood in his or her body.
- White blood cells are the body's primary defence against infection.
- Granulocytes, a type of white blood cell, roll along blood vessel walls to search and destroy bacteria.
- Red blood cells carry oxygen to the body's organs and tissues.
- There are about one billion red blood cells in two to three drops of blood.
- Red blood cells live about 120 days in the circulatory system.
- Blood platelets help clotting and give those with leukemia and other cancers a chance to live.

### Facts about blood needs

- Every year our nation requires about 4 Crore units of blood, out of which only a meager 40 Lakh units of blood are available.
- The gift of blood is the gift of life. There is no substitute for human blood.
- Every two seconds someone needs blood.
- More than 38,000 blood donations are needed every day.
- A total of 30 million blood components are transfused each year.
- The average red blood cell transfusion is approximately 3 pints. The blood type most often requested by hospitals is Type O.
- Sickle cell patients can require frequent blood transfusions throughout their lives.

• More than 1 million new people are diagnosed with cancer each year. Many of them will need blood, sometimes daily, during their chemotherapy treatment.

### Facts about the blood supply

- Blood cannot be manufactured it can only come from generous donors.
- Type O-negative blood (red cells) can be transfused to patients of all blood types. It is always in great demand and often in short supply.
- Type AB-positive plasma can be transfused to patients of all other blood types. AB plasma is also usually in short supply.

### Facts about the blood donation process

- Donating blood is a safe process. A sterile needle is used only once for each donor and then discarded.
  Blood donation is a simple four-step process: registration, medical history and mini-physical, donation and refreshments.
- Every blood donor is given a mini-physical, checking the donor's temperature, blood pressure, pulse and hemoglobin to ensure it is safe for the donor to give blood.
- The actual blood donation typically takes less than 10-12 minutes. The entire process, from the time you arrive to the time you leave, takes about an hour and 15 min.
- The average adult has about 10 units of blood in his body. Roughly 1 unit is given during a donation.
- A healthy donor may donate red blood cells every 56 days, or double red cells every 112 days.
- A healthy donor may donate platelets as few as 7 days apart, but a maximum of 24 times a year.
- All donated blood is tested for HIV, hepatitis B and C, syphilis and other infectious diseases before it can be transfused to patients.

### **Blood and its components**

- Blood makes up about 7 percent of body's weight.
- There are four types of transfusionable products that can be derived from blood: red cells, platelets, plasma and cryoprecipitate. Typically, two or three of these are produced from a unit of donated whole blood hence each donation can help save up to three lives.

- Donors can give either whole blood or specific blood components only. The process of donating specific blood components red cells, plasma or platelets is called apheresis.
- One transfusion dose of platelets can be obtained through one apheresis donation of platelets or by combining the platelets derived from five whole blood donations.
- Donated platelets must be used within five days of collection.
- Healthy bone marrow makes a constant supply of red cells, plasma and platelets. The body will replenish the elements given during a blood donation some in a matter of hours and others in a matter of weeks.

### **Examples of blood use**

- Automobile Accident 50 units of blood
- Heart Surgery 6 units of blood / 6 units of platelets
- Organ Transplant 40 units of blood / 30 units of platelets
- 20 bags of cryoprecipitate 25 units of fresh frozen plasma
- Bone Marrow Transplant 120 units of platelets/ 20 units of blood
- Burn Victims 20 units of platelets

### Who can Donate

- You are between age group of 18-60 years.
- Your weight is 45 kg or more.
- Your haemoglobin is 12.5 gm% minimum.
- Your last blood donation was 3 months earlier.
- You are healthy and have not suffered from malaria, typhoid or other transmissible disease in the recent past.
- There are many, many people who meet these parameters of health and fitness!
- Do abide by our rules be truthful about your health status!
- Hospitals ensure the health of blood, before they take it, as well as after it is collected. Firstly, the donor is expected to be honest about his or her health history and current condition. Secondly, collected blood is tested for venereal diseases, hepatitis B & C and AIDS.

### Who cannot Donate

- Do not donate blood if you have any of these conditions
- Cold / fever in the past 1 week.
- Under treatment with antibiotics or any other medication.
- Cardiac problems, hypertension, epilepsy, diabetes (on insulin therapy), history of cancer, chronic kidney or liver disease, bleeding tendencies, venereal disease etc.
- Major surgery in the last 6 months.
- Vaccination in the last 24 hours.
- Had fainting attacks during last donation.
- Have regularly received treatment with blood products.
- Shared a needle to inject drugs/ have history of drug addiction.
- Been tested positive for antibodies to HIV.

### **Before the Donation**

- Maintain a healthy iron level in your diet by eating iron rich foods, such as spinach, red meat etc.
- Get a good night's sleep.
- Drink an extra 16 oz. of water and fluids before the donation.
- Remember to bring your College ID and one other form of ID.

### **During the Donation**

- Wear clothing with sleeves that can be raised above the elbow.
- Relax, listen to music, talk to other donors or read during the donation process.
- Take the time to enjoy a snack and a drink in the refreshments area immediately after donating.

### After the Donation

- Drink plenty of fluids over the next 24-48 hours to replenish any fluids you lost during donation.
- Avoid exhausting physical activity for about five hours after donation.
- If you feel light headed, lie down, preferably with feet elevated, until the feeling passes.

- In rare cases when bleeding occurs after removing the bandage, apply pressure to the site and raise your arm for 3-5 minutes. If bleeding or bruising occurs under the skin, apply a cold pack to the area periodically during the first 24 hours.
- It takes eight weeks for your body to replace the iron lost while donating blood. In 60 days, return to the blood bank to donate again and save another three lives.
