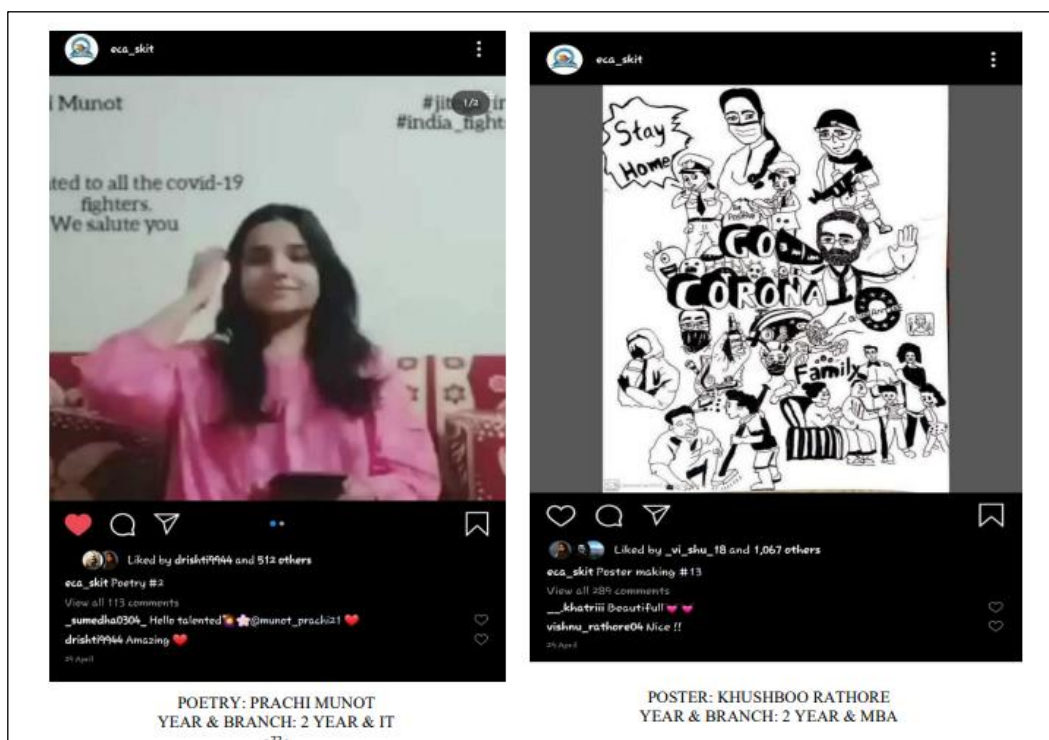
On The Theme

Every 100 years or so, humanity witnesses and endures nature's curveballs which claim millions of lives. Pandemics such as plague, cholera, Spanish flu have laughed in the face of our medical advancements and struck the weakest section of the population the hardest. The situation is no different this time with coronavirus, maybe worse. COVID-19 has created unique challenges for different segments of the population and struck at the very heart of the machinery designed to protect people from such calamities.

- Swami Keshvanand Institute of Technology, Management and Gramothan Jaipur Rajasthan have contributed Rs 11.0 lakh rupees to the Rajasthan Chief Minister Relief Fund to support the COVID relief efforts cause of the state.
- SKIT is supporting a mass campaign, in Dantli villages and have been educated about COVID, by Public address systems, door-to-door visits, banners and posters at prominent locations.
- Fumigation has been done covering more than 1000 inhabitants and they have distributed masks and sanitizers in the villages.
- Every day freshly cooked food packets were being given by following social distancing and lockdown norms. The SKIT is providing 350 meals a day at Dantli villages and Ramnagriya and will be distributed till the lockdown continues. These meals are cooked in the kitchens of SKIT canteens. The best part of our food distribution system was that SKIT was going door to door.
- Furthermore, employees of the SKIT have voluntarily decided to contribute their one days' salary to the Chief Minister Relief Fund to support the government in combating this national crisis.

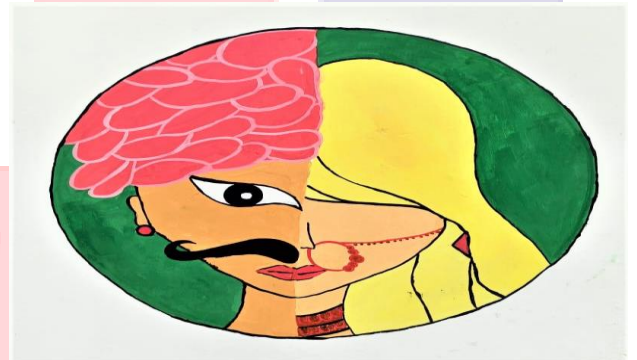

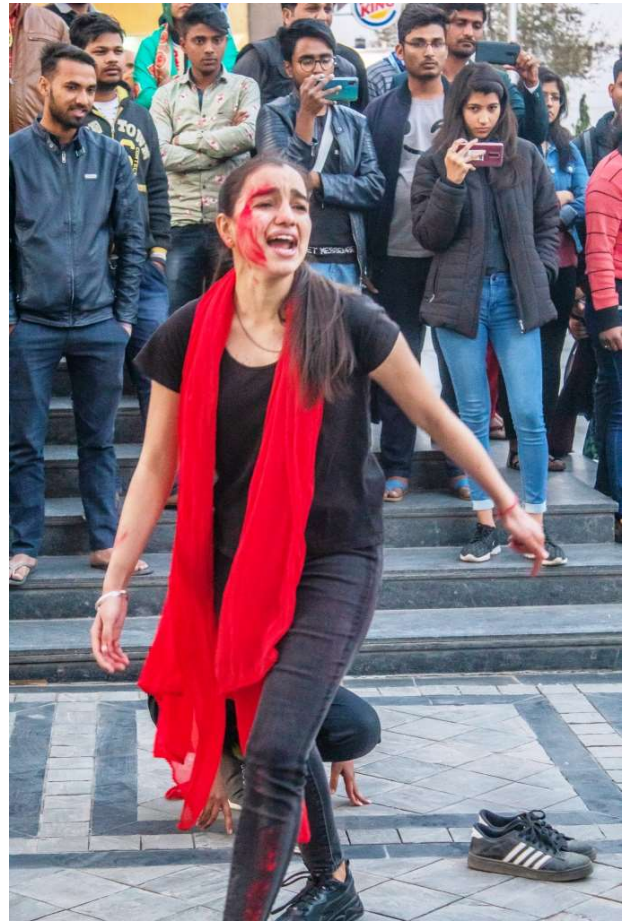
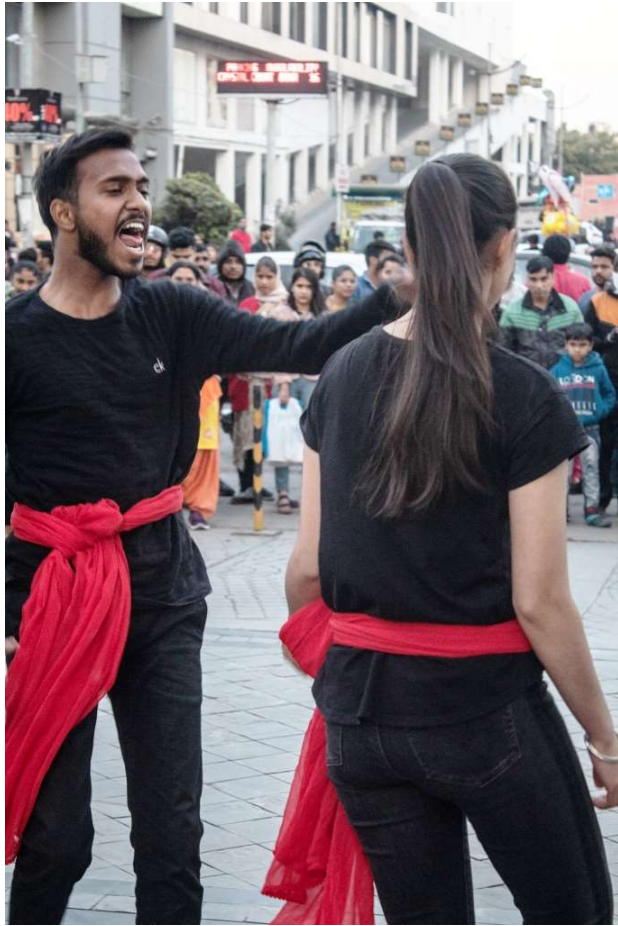

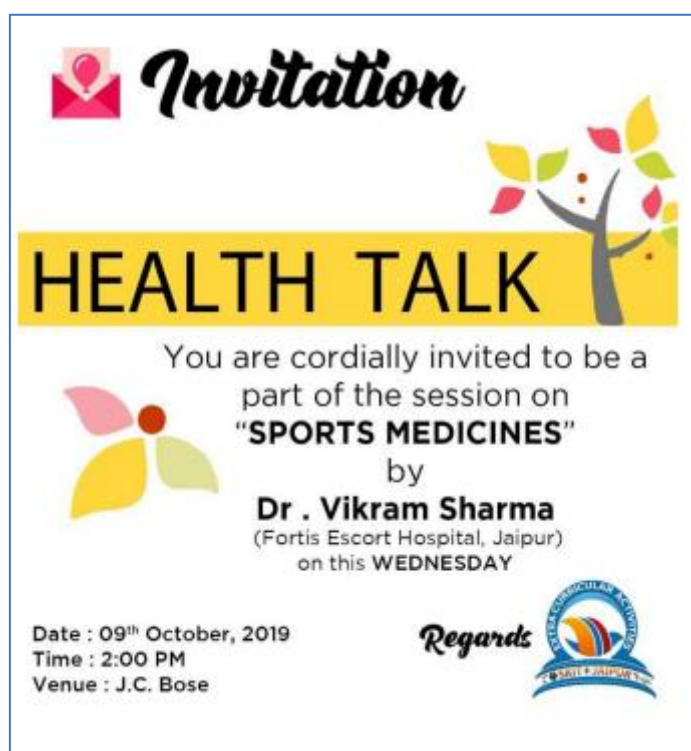
He stressed education for democracy and national development. He has emphasized that an education which develops character, mental powers and intelligence gives self-confidence and self-reliance among the individuals.

The workshop ended with the explaining of the process of eliminating these things from life and a thankful note by Dr. Neha Purohit. More than 650 students participated in the event.







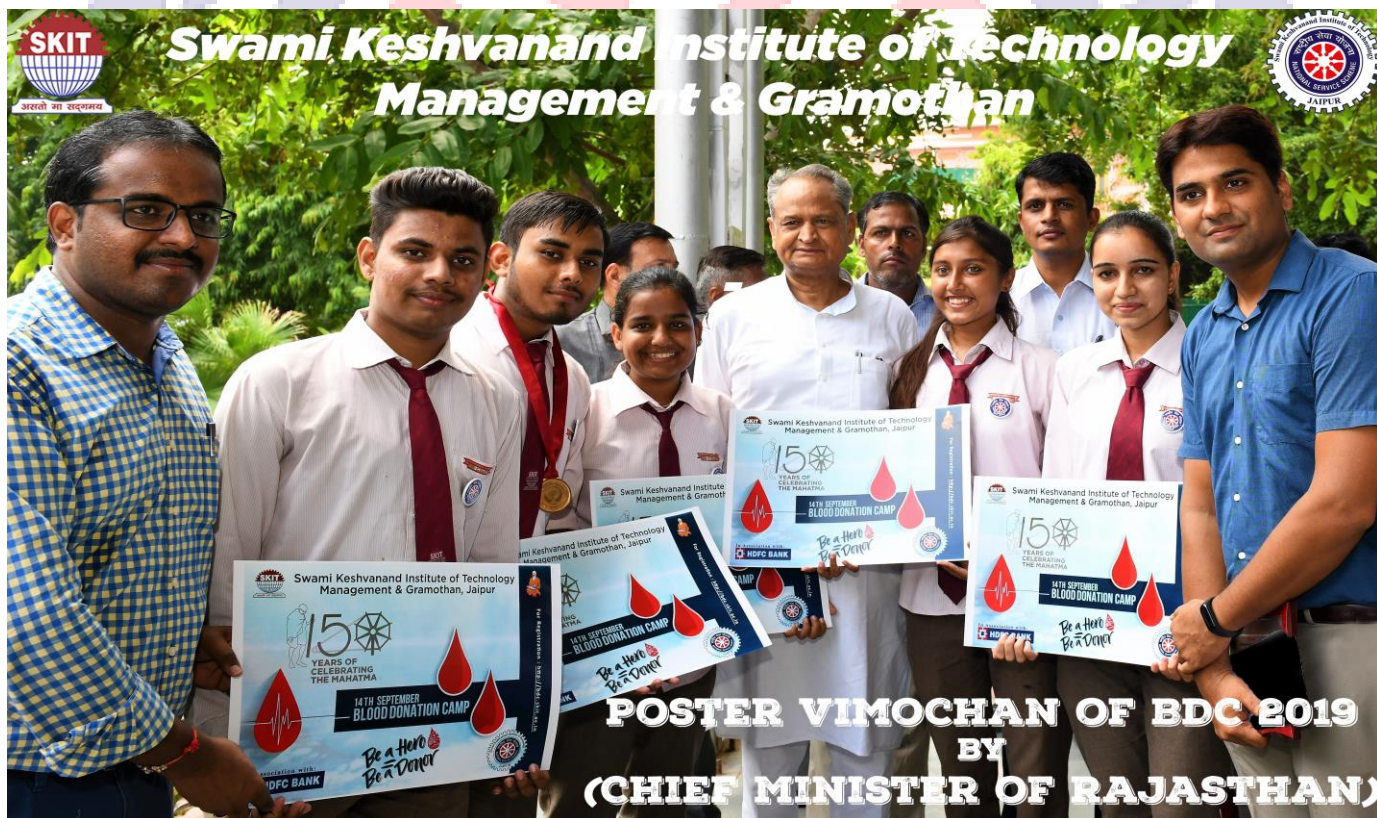

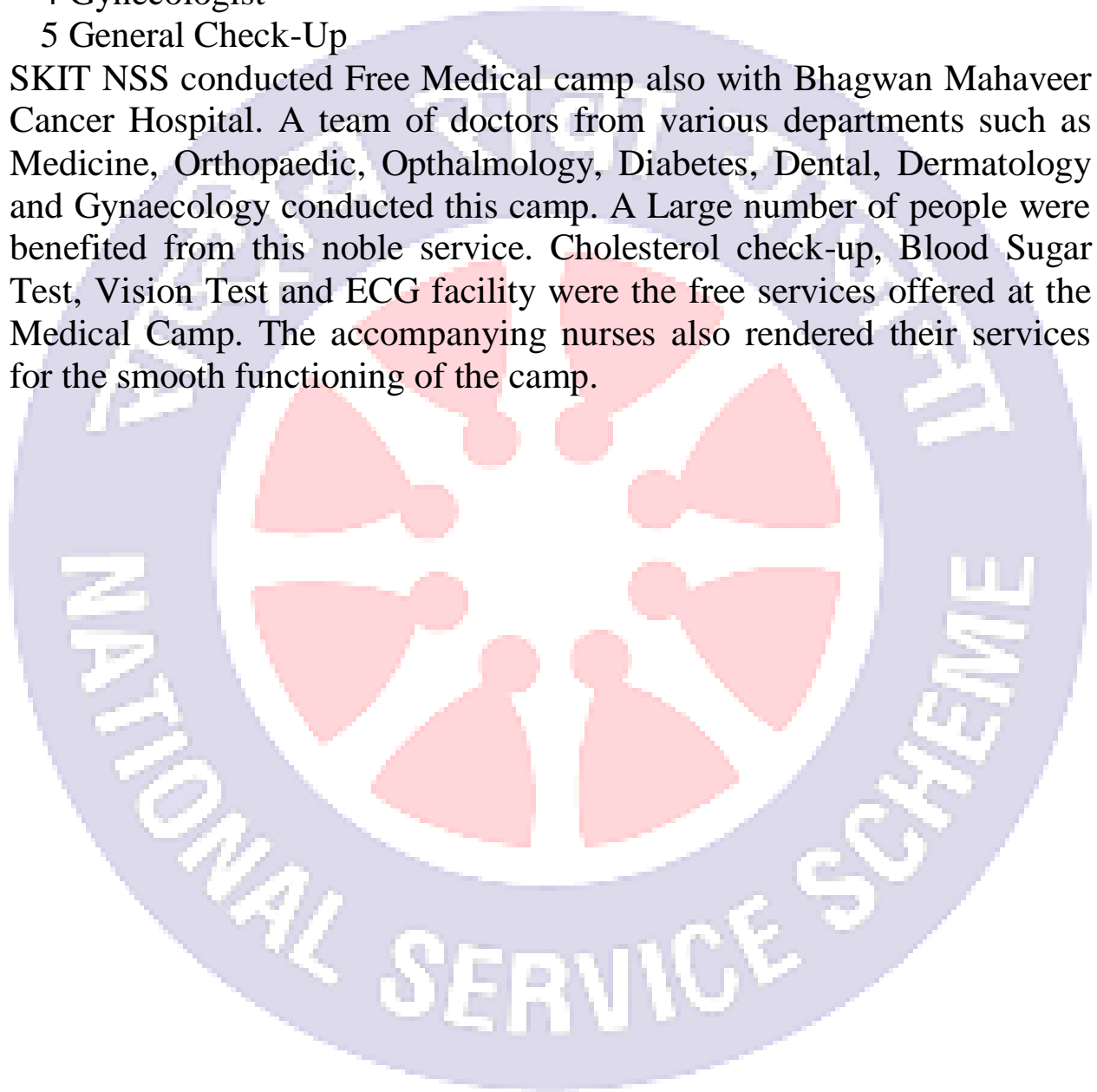

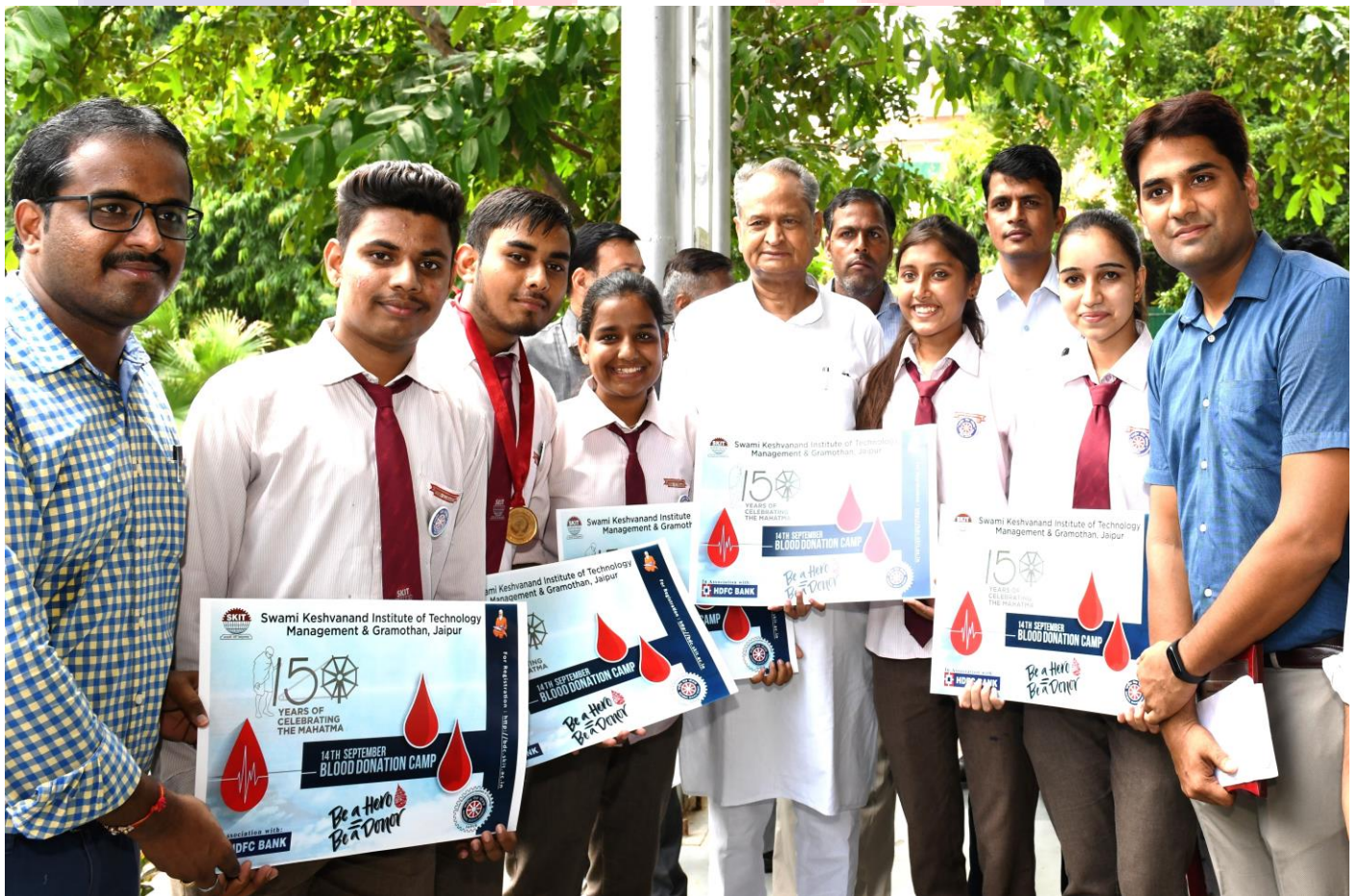
