
Online Competition on POSTER and POETRY On The Theme

Pandemics such as plague, cholera, Spanish flu have laughed in the face of our medical advancements and struck the weakest section of the population the hardest. The situation is no different this time with coronavirus, maybe worse. COVID-19 has created unique challenges for different segments of the population and struck at the very heart of the machinery designed to protect people from such calamities.

- Swami Keshvanand Institute of Technology, Management and Gramothan Jaipur Rajasthan have contributed Rs 11.0 lakh rupees to the Rajasthan Chief Minister Relief Fund to support the COVID relief efforts cause of the state.
- SKIT is supporting a mass campaign, in Dantli villages and have been educated about COVID, by Public address systems, door-to-door visits, banners and posters at prominent locations.
