

### **Objective of the Event:-**

To develop a steady mind, strong will power

### **Details (Execution):-**

Prāṇāyāma is the practice of breath control in yoga. In modern yoga as exercise, it consists of synchronising the breath with movements between asanas, but is also a distinct breathing exercise on its own, usually practised after asanas. In texts like the Bhagavad Gita and the Yoga Sutras of Patanjali, and later in Hatha yoga texts, it meant the complete cessation of breathing.

### **Benefits of Pranayama**

- Improves sleep quality. The stress-relieving effects of pranayama may also help you sleep.
- Increases mindfulness. For many of us, breathing is automatic.
- Reduces high blood pressure.
- Enhances cognitive performance.

Benefits of Garudasana

### **Details (Execution):-**

Garudasana is an asymmetric position in which one leg, say the right, is crossed over the left, while the arm on the opposite side, say the left, is crossed over the right, and the palms are pressed together. Like all poses on one leg, it demands, and may help to build, balance and concentration. According to Satyananda Saraswati, the two palms pressed together resemble the eagle's beak. The gaze is directed at a fixed point in front.

### **Benefits of Garudasana:-**

- Strengthens and stretches the ankles and calves.
- Stretches the thighs, hips, shoulders, and upper back.
- Improves concentration.
- Improves sense of balance.

## **Vrikshasana**

### **Objective of the Event: -**

Improves balance and stability in the legs. Strengthens the ligaments and tendon of the feet.

### **Details (Execution):-**

The modern hatha yoga we practice, as well as derivatives like ashtanga and vinyasa, have their roots in ancient yoga, albeit with modern interpretations. However, one of the most common asanas that have found its way down the ages and remained undiluted is the vrikshasana. This is derived from two words 'vriksha', which means tree in Sanskrit, and 'asana', which means posture. This 'tree pose' dates back to ancient mythology, and there are in fact references of it in the Ramayana.

### **Benefits of vrikshasana:-**

- Improves balance and stability in the legs.
- On a metaphysical level, helps one to achieve balance in other aspects of life.
- Strengthens the ligaments and tendon of the feet.
- Strengthens and tones the entire standing leg, up to the buttocks.

## **Kapalabhati**

### **Objective of the Event:-**

Due to the process, the organs under the skull mainly the brain and the small brain are influenced in a good manner

### **Details (Execution):-**

Kapalabhati , also known as Skull Shining Breath, is an energizing breathing practice that clears the lungs, the nasal passages, and the mind. In Sanskrit, Kapal means “cranium” or “forehead” and bhati means “light,” “perception,” and “knowledge.” Kapalabhati therefore brings lightness and clarity to the frontal region of the brain. Requiring a rapid contraction and release of the abdomen, this is an active pranayama that focuses primarily on the exhalation; the inhalation occurs passively and without effort. Kapalabhati is tridoshically balancing.

### **Benefits of kapalabhati:-**

- Balances excess vata, pitta, and kapha
- Cleanses the lungs
- Improves circulation, particularly in the head
- Eliminates mental distractions and invites alertness.

## **Tadasanaa**

**Date:** - 23/10/19

### **Objective of the Event:-**

Regulate the menstrual cycle in women. Tone your buttocks and abdomen. Strengthens your ankles, knees, thighs, arms, and legs.

### **Details (Execution):-**

It is a basic standing asana in most forms of yoga with feet together and hands at the sides of the body. There is some contention between different styles of yoga regarding the details of the asana which results in some variations. The posture is entered by standing with the feet together, grounding evenly through the feet and lifting up through the crown of the head. The thighs are lifted, the waist is lifted, and the spine is elongated. Breathing is relaxed. Although Tāḍāsana is a basic asana, it is the basis for many standing asanas. As such, it is important as it allows the body and consciousness to integrate the experience of the preceding āsana and to prepare for the next.

### **Benefits of Tadasana:-**

- May Help Increases Height.
- Boosts Mental Awareness.
- Improves Breathing.
- Promotes Weight Loss.
- Boosts Energy Levels.

## **Bhujangasana**

**Date:** - 06/11/19

**Venue:** - Civil Block

**Time:** - 01:30-3:30

### **Objective of the Event: -**

The aim is to make a gentle bow shape with your spine and to increase the flexibility and strength of mainly your lower back

### **Details (Execution):-**

The pose may be entered from a prone position or from Downward Dog. The palms are placed under the shoulders, pushing down until the hips lift slightly. The backs of the feet rest on the ground, the legs outstretched; the gaze is directed forwards, giving the preparatory pose. For the full pose, the back is arched until the arms are straight, and the gaze is directed straight upwards or a little backwards. The legs remain on the ground, unlike in the similar Upward Dog pose.

### **Benefits of Bhujangasana:-**

- Strengthens the spine.
- Stretches chest and lungs, shoulders, and abdomen.
- Tones the buttocks.
- Stimulates abdominal organs.

**About The Club:-**

NATIONAL SERVICE SCHEME popularly known as NSS was launched in Gandhi's Centenary Year 1969, under the Ministry of Youth Affairs & Sports Govt. of India. The scheme was launched simultaneously in 37 Universities involving 40,000 students with primary focus on the development of personality of students through community service and promotion of National solidarity. In India, the idea of involving students in the task of national service dates back to the times of Mahatma Gandhi, the father of the nation. The central theme which he tried to impress upon his student audience time and again was that they should always keep before them, their social responsibility. The duty of the students should be, not to treat their period of study as one of the opportunities for indulgence in intellectual luxury, but for preparing themselves for final dedication in the service of those who provided the sinews of the nation with the national goods & services so essential to society. Advising them to form a living contact with the community in whose midst their institution is located, he suggested that instead of undertaking academic research about economic and social disability, the students should do "something positive so that the life of the villagers might be raised to a higher material and moral level". NSS works on the premise that it is possible to awaken the villagers and slum dwellers to their responsibilities and develop in them the confidence, to tackle their common problems with energy, enthusiasm and in a co-operative spirit, based on mutual aid and self-reliance. The role of students is limited as activists, enablers, catalytic agents with wider communities and as program aids.

### **About the Camp:-**

Voluntary blood donors are the cornerstone of a safe and adequate supply of blood and blood products. The safest blood donors are voluntary, non-remunerated blood donors from low-risk populations.

Despite this notion, family/replacement donors still provide more than 45% of the blood collected in India. Such donors are supposed to be associated with a significantly higher prevalence of transfusion-transmissible infections (TTIs) including HIV, hepatitis B, hepatitis C, syphilis and malaria. For a safe blood service in our country, where comprehensive laboratory tests are neither possible nor pragmatic, it is best to switch over to 100% voluntary donations, as it is now established that only voluntary non-remunerated regular donation is the safest. Thus, one of our key strategies to enhance blood safety is to focus on motivating non-remunerated blood donors and phasing out even replacement donors. The key to recruiting and retaining safe blood donors is good epidemiological data on the prevalence (and incidence, where possible) of infectious markers in the general population to identify low-risk donor populations coupled with an effective donor education, motivation and recruitment strategy to recruit new voluntary non remunerated blood donors from these populations. A pleasant environment in the blood bank, good donor care, polite and effective communication between staff and donors are all important factors for the retention of blood donors.

### **Objective of the Programme:**

3. Encouraging new people to donate their blood on a voluntary unpaid basis.
4. for saving others life who need blood in emergency.

Swami keshvanand Institute of technology management and Grammothan have been organizing the blood donation camps every year since 2000, form the inception of the college.

## **Preamble**

The first record of the voluntary blood donation initiative in India is noted in 1942, at the time of World War II and the first blood bank was established in Kolkata, West Bengal. The blood bank was set up at that time to fulfill the blood needs of those injured in the battle field. Government employees and industrial houses volunteered to donate blood for this humanitarian cause. Once the war ended, the enthusiasm waned and blood bank collections were largely from professional or the paid blood donors. A decade passed by till Mrs. Leela Moolgaokar initiated voluntary blood donation drive in Bombay (now Mumbai) from 1954 onwards. She was inspired by the blood need of her injured son. In 1971, Prof. J.G. Jolly the founder President of the Indian Society of Blood Transfusion and Immunohaematology took the movement to further heights and the Society under his stewardship declared **October 1 as National Voluntary Blood Donation Day** which was later accepted by the government too. Since then many blood donor organizations came up in different regions of the country in support of the noble cause of voluntary blood donation. The National Blood Policy (2002) and an Action Plan for Blood Safety (2003) were adopted by the Government of India. The NBTC (National Blood Transfusion Council) was entrusted with planning a national campaign.

There are four main blood types: A, B, AB and O. In 1901, Karl Landsteiner, an Austrian physician, discovers the first three human blood groups. On his birthday **June 14th "World Blood Donors Day" is celebrated.**

SKIT has always been engaged in the activities of human concern and societal & environmental development. We have been organizing Blood donation camps since long time.

17th Annual Mega Voluntary Blood Donation Camp was organized on 1st October 2018 (National Blood Donation Day) by SKIT Red Cross Club & NSS Club.

This session (2018-2019) we organized two camps. Over whelming response of blood donors was amazing. Our sincere efforts have witnessed a progressive increase in voluntary blood donation every year. The concern for blood donor safety was also taken care of. The current scenario is definitely hopeful. Seasonal variations also account for fluctuations in blood collections.

Thus in conclusion it can be stated with confidence that our Blood donation programme is successfully gaining strength.

## ***Blood Facts***

### **Blood: Life-maintaining fluid**

- Blood is the life-maintaining fluid that circulates through the body's heart, arteries, veins and capillaries.
- Blood carries to the body nourishment, electrolytes, hormones, vitamins, antibodies, heat, and oxygen.
- Blood carries away from the body waste matter and carbon dioxide.
- Blood fights against infection and helps heal wounds, keeping you healthy.
- Blood makes up about 7% of your body's weight.
- A newborn baby has about one cup of blood in his or her body.
- White blood cells are the body's primary defence against infection.
- Granulocytes, a type of white blood cell, roll along blood vessel walls to search and destroy bacteria.
- Red blood cells carry oxygen to the body's organs and tissues.
- There are about one billion red blood cells in two to three drops of blood.
- Red blood cells live about 120 days in the circulatory system.
- Blood platelets help clotting and give those with leukemia and other cancers a chance to live.

### **Facts about blood needs**

- Every year our nation requires about 4 Crore units of blood, out of which only a meager 40 Lakh units of blood are available.
- The gift of blood is the gift of life. There is no substitute for human blood.
- Every two seconds someone needs blood.
- More than 38,000 blood donations are needed every day.
- A total of 30 million blood components are transfused each year.
- The average red blood cell transfusion is approximately 3 pints. • The blood type most often requested by hospitals is Type O.
- Sickle cell patients can require frequent blood transfusions throughout their lives.



- More than 1 million new people are diagnosed with cancer each year. Many of them will need blood, sometimes daily, during their chemotherapy treatment.

### **Facts about the blood supply**

- Blood cannot be manufactured – it can only come from generous donors.
- Type O-negative blood (red cells) can be transfused to patients of all blood types. It is always in great demand and often in short supply.
- Type AB-positive plasma can be transfused to patients of all other blood types. AB plasma is also usually in short supply.

### **Facts about the blood donation process**

- Donating blood is a safe process. A sterile needle is used only once for each donor and then discarded.
- Blood donation is a simple four-step process: registration, medical history and mini-physical, donation and refreshments.
- Every blood donor is given a mini-physical, checking the donor's temperature, blood pressure, pulse and hemoglobin to ensure it is safe for the donor to give blood.
- The actual blood donation typically takes less than 10-12 minutes. The entire process, from the time you arrive to the time you leave, takes about an hour and 15 min.
- **The average adult has about 10 units of blood in his body. Roughly 1 unit is given during a donation.**
- **A healthy donor may donate red blood cells every 56 days, or double red cells every 112 days.**
- **A healthy donor may donate platelets as few as 7 days apart, but a maximum of 24 times a year.**
- All donated blood is tested for HIV, hepatitis B and C, syphilis and other infectious diseases before it can be transfused to patients.

### **Blood and its components**

- Blood makes up about 7 percent of body's weight.
- There are four types of transfusionable products that can be derived from blood: red cells, platelets, plasma and cryoprecipitate. Typically, two or three of these are produced from a unit of donated whole blood – hence each donation can help save up to three lives.

- Donors can give either whole blood or specific blood components only. The process of donating specific blood components – red cells, plasma or platelets – is called apheresis.
- One transfusion dose of platelets can be obtained through one apheresis donation of platelets or by combining the platelets derived from five whole blood donations.
- Donated platelets must be used within five days of collection.
- Healthy bone marrow makes a constant supply of red cells, plasma and platelets. The body will replenish the elements given during a blood donation – some in a matter of hours and others in a matter of weeks.

### **Examples of blood use**

- Automobile Accident 50 units of blood
- Heart Surgery 6 units of blood / 6 units of platelets
- Organ Transplant 40 units of blood / 30 units of platelets
- 20 bags of cryoprecipitate 25 units of fresh frozen plasma
- Bone Marrow Transplant 120 units of platelets/ 20 units of blood
- Burn Victims 20 units of platelets

### **Who can Donate**

- You are between age group of 18-60 years.
- Your weight is 45 kg or more.
- Your haemoglobin is 12.5 gm% minimum.
- Your last blood donation was 3 months earlier.
- You are healthy and have not suffered from malaria, typhoid or other transmissible disease in the recent past.
- There are many, many people who meet these parameters of health and fitness!
- Do abide by our rules - be truthful about your health status!
- Hospitals ensure the health of blood, before they take it, as well as after it is collected. Firstly, the donor is expected to be honest about his or her health history and current condition. Secondly, collected blood is tested for venereal diseases, hepatitis B & C and AIDS.

## **Who cannot Donate**

- Do not donate blood if you have any of these conditions
- Cold / fever in the past 1 week.
- Under treatment with antibiotics or any other medication.
- Cardiac problems, hypertension, epilepsy, diabetes (on insulin therapy), history of cancer, chronic kidney or liver disease, bleeding tendencies, venereal disease etc.
- Major surgery in the last 6 months.
- Vaccination in the last 24 hours.
- Had fainting attacks during last donation.
- Have regularly received treatment with blood products.
- Shared a needle to inject drugs/ have history of drug addiction.
- Been tested positive for antibodies to HIV.

## **Before the Donation**

- Maintain a healthy iron level in your diet by eating iron rich foods, such as spinach, red meat etc.
- Get a good night's sleep.
- Drink an extra 16 oz. of water and fluids before the donation.
- Remember to bring your College ID and one other form of ID.

## **During the Donation**

- Wear clothing with sleeves that can be raised above the elbow.
- Relax, listen to music, talk to other donors or read during the donation process.
- Take the time to enjoy a snack and a drink in the refreshments area immediately after donating.

## **After the Donation**

- Drink plenty of fluids over the next 24-48 hours to replenish any fluids you lost during donation.
- Avoid exhausting physical activity for about five hours after donation.
- If you feel light headed, lie down, preferably with feet elevated, until the feeling passes.

- In rare cases when bleeding occurs after removing the bandage, apply pressure to the site and raise your arm for 3-5 minutes. If bleeding or bruising occurs under the skin, apply a cold pack to the area periodically during the first 24 hours.
- It takes eight weeks for your body to replace the iron lost while donating blood. In 60 days, return to the blood bank to donate again and save another three lives.
