

The startup culture has taken the world of business by a storm. He addressed that not only are these young companies with big dreamers openly welcoming “skilled” individuals more than “qualified” but are also playing a vital role in building the economy of the country. Since the decision-making process is not cumbersome, the startup environment is adaptable to changes, which ultimately leads to maximizing profits by innovation.

The second session, was addressed by Shri. N.K Jain, Hony. Secretary General, RSPC, on – ‘International Landscape of Innovation’. Shri. N.K Jain, discussed about the 3C’s for a successful startup i.e. commitment, confidence, & creativity. He talked about several government schemes launched for developing and encouraging entrepreneurship in India like, Start up India Initiative, ASPIRE, Mudra Bank, Multiplier Grant Scheme(MGS), New Gen Innovation & Entrepreneurship Development Centre, the Venture Capital Assistance Scheme & Credit Guarantee, etc. Shri. N.K Jain also discussed, why startups fails in India? Some of the reasons are stated as under:

The third session was addressed by Shri K.L. Jain, President, RSPC, on – ‘Effect of Covid on the economy of India: Issues & Challenges’. He addressed that the economic impact of coronavirus pandemic in India has been largely

disruptive. India's growth in the fourth quarter of the fiscal year 2020 went down to 3.1% according to the Ministry of Statistics. The Government of India announced a variety of measures to tackle the situation, from food security and extra funds for healthcare and for the states, to sector related incentives and tax deadline extensions. Startups play a key role in OECD economies, but the COVID-19 crisis is reducing their creation, challenging their survival, and limiting their growth. He also emphasized that the business registrations have been dropping significantly in recent months and a missing generation of new firms has significant implications for economic outcomes, notably employment. Policymakers should tackle short-term challenges, supporting short-term liquidity and availability of funding, but also and importantly foster the ability of start-ups to grasp new business opportunities. Policies that reduce barriers to entrepreneurship, provide incentives for start-ups, and boost entrepreneurial potential could help speed up the recovery and preserve aggregate employment in the long term. Shri K.L. Jain suggested students to read newspapers related to economy of our country & the entire world i.e., Economic Times, Business Standard, Financial Express, & Mint etc. to stay ahead in the competitive world and also motivated the students to take advantage of the startup policies and initiate their own startups. The seminar ended with Dr. Ona Ladiwal presenting her vote of thanks. The National Seminar was a huge success.
